At Messiah, we love walking with children and youth on their journeys to follow Jesus. To do that, we offer several Sunday morning classes: Children in pre-K through 5th grade gather for KID Street Sunday School during worship. Kids begin in worship, are released to Sunday School mid-service, and can be picked up downstairs after worship. Youth in grades 6-8 gather in the Youth Room for Sunday School during both the 8:45 and 10:30 am worship services. Youth begin in worship and are dismissed with the kids mid-service. All children and youth are always welcome to remain in the sanctuary if your family prefers to worship together.

Nursery care is available during worship for infants and toddlers (through age 3). Children can be dropped off downstairs in the KID Street HQ before worship begins. Prefer to keep your little one with you? We're not bothered by wiggles or noise! If it's helpful, "busy bags" are available at the back of the sanctuary, and worship is streaming in the atrium and Heritage Hall. Ushers are happy to help guide you.

An **induction hearing loop** is available in our sanctuary for those with t-coil hearing aids or cochlear implants.

Just a reminder that Messiah Church follows the winter weather closings of the Wayzata School District. If Wayzata Schools are closed or school district activities are canceled because of weather. Messiah will also be closed and all events canceled. We will do our best to communicate these changes — please check our website and social media for updates, watch local TV for Wayzata School closings, or call the church office at (763) 473-6968 if you are unsure about your event. As always, please use your best judgment driving in any winter weather. Worship is always available to stream online, from the comfort of your home, at MessiahChurch.org/live.

Each year, Messiah Church selects two organizations to receive our special Christmas Offering. Your 2025 Christmas Offering is a gift to the Totes for Hope food shelf and the Immigration Law & Justice **Network: Totes for Hope** is a food shelf ministry of Messiah Church to help minimize food insecurity for Bloom Early Learning & Child Care families. Started in 2018, this selfselect food shelf is available throughout the week, all year long, allowing families to take what food they need, when they need it. Your Christmas Offering fully funds purchasing food for this program for the entire year. **Immigration** Law & Justice Network (ILJN) provides free or low-cost legal

counsel, advocacy, and support to low-income immigrants seeking legal status in the United States. Through a national network, they promote justice and foster safety, trust, and belonging. Each year, ILJN serves nearly 7,000 immigrants, refugees, and asylumseekers. ILJN was founded by **UMCOR** (United Methodist Committee on Relief) in 1999 as a ministry of the United Methodist Church, and continues to be a partner organization. Registration is open for both of the Messiah Youth summer mission opportunities — for students and adult leaders. Youth in grades 7-12 will be serving at STORM Camp Woodbury (Service To Others in Relational Ministry) July 12-16,

2026. We do two things at STORM Camp: work and worship. Projects include things like painting, yard work, minor construction, and demolition jobs — but we also work to grow in relationships with those we're serving and those we're serving alongside. Youth in grades 9-12 are headed to Louisville, KY, for a YouthWorks Mission Trip, July 25- August 1, 2026. We'll be partnering with local organizations to serve children in the community, spend time with the elderly, and/or serve those experiencing homelessness. In the evenings, enjoy time with new community friends and maybe a visit to Churchill Downs, the home of the Kentucky Derby. The YouthWorks Mission Trip is a great experience for youth interested in learning more about what they can do to serve the under-served and contribute to the greater good.
