Started in 2018, this self-select food shelf is available throughout the week, all year long, allowing families to take what food they need, when they need it. On Sunday, January 18, join us for a special day of Worship & Service in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. We'll gather for ONE combined worship service at 9:30 am and come together to pack meals with Harvest Pack, an organization that addresses food insecurity through meal-packing events. Our goal is to pack 16,500 fortified oatmeal meals that will be distributed to support those in need right here in our community. There will be opportunities to serve either before or after worship, with shifts lasting about 45 minutes (similar to packing meals at Feed My Starving Children — involves standing and measuring ingredients into bags; some seated jobs are also available). This is a family-friendly event — children as young as 3 are welcome to participate! A sign-up will be available starting January 1 at MessiahChurch.org/make-an-impact to help us plan, though walk-ins are also welcome. Please note the special worship time and invite others to join us for this meaningful day as we honor Dr. King's legacy of community, justice, and compassion.
