At Messiah, we love walking with children and youth on their journeys to follow Jesus. To do that, we offer several Sunday morning classes: Children in pre-K through 5th grade gather for KID Street Sunday School at 8:45 and 10:30 am. Kids begin in worship, are released to Sunday School mid-service, and can be picked up downstairs after worship. Youth in grades 6-8 gather in the Youth Room for Sunday School during both the 8:45 and 10:30 am worship services. Youth begin in worship and are dismissed with the kids mid-service. Nursery care, for infants and toddlers (through age 3), is available at both services, and these children may be dropped off downstairs in KID Street HQ before worship begins. All children and youth are always welcome to remain in the sanctuary if your family prefers to worship together.

Altar flowers today are given by Jerry and Marlys Skoblik, who are celebrating their 48th wedding anniversary this week.

For those with t-coil equipped hearing aids or cochlear implants, an **induction hearing loop** is installed for use in our sanctuary.

Students in grades 6-12 have opportunities to connect with peers and grow in their faith at Messiah Church with several youth programs! Middle School Sunday School for youth in grades 6-8 resumes today. Sunday School meets in the Youth Room during both worship services and offers age-appropriate teaching that uses creative storytelling and thoughtful approaches to engaging with Scripture. The first Sunday of each month, instead of Sunday School, youth are invited to stay in worship with their families. Wednesday Nights from 6:30-7 pm, we have dinner together and hang out. From 7-8 pm Middle School Youth Group meets in Lakeside East and High School Youth Group meets in the Youth Room. Confirmation for Youth in High School (grades 9+) begins with a parent/Confirmand meeting on Sunday, October 5 at 9:45 am and classes in November. Stay tuned for more information, coming soon. (Please register all youth in your family - 6th-12th grade.) We're always looking for adults to join us and come alongside youth in their faith journeys. We'd welcome new adult leaders in all program areas, but specifically have needs on the second Sunday of the month at 8:45 and the third Sunday of the month at 10:30 for Sunday School. KID Street Wednesday Nights are back! Children pre-K through 5th grade can join us from 6:30-8 pm for dinner, a faith lesson, friendship, and an opportunity to worship through art or service. KID Street Wednesday Nights begin in the KID Street Headquarters (the Sunday School room downstairs). Care for children under age 4 may be available - contact Kari Stern, Director of Children and Family Ministry, at kstern@messiahchurch.org at least 2 days in advance to check on availability. Each year, we ask
