Today is "Worship Together

Sunday," where we have a single worship service in a blended style so all the Messiah family can worship together. If you come back another Sunday, we offer a traditional service at 8:45 am with our organ and choir, and a contemporary service at 10:30 am led by the praise band. Coffee hour follows each service.

At Messiah, we love walking with children and youth on their journeys to follow Jesus. To do that, we offer several Sunday morning classes for children in pre-K through 5th grade and Middle School Youth in grades 6-8. Today, they will gather for a special combined movie day Sunday School in the KID Street space downstairs. Kids will begin in worship, and be released to Sunday School mid-service. All children and youth are always welcome to remain in the sanctuary if your family prefers to worship together.

Nursery care is available during worship for infants and toddlers (through age 3). Children can be dropped off downstairs in the KID Street HQ before worship begins. Prefer to keep your little one with you? We're not bothered by wiggles or noise! If it's helpful, "busy bags" are available at the back of the sanctuary, and worship is streaming in the atrium and

Heritage Hall. Ushers are happy to help guide you.

An **induction hearing loop** is available in our sanctuary for those with t-coil hearing aids or cochlear implants.

We have been made aware of **phishing emails** circulating that appear to come from Pastor Tami. We want to remind you to be careful and alert with your internet safety. We will never ask you to verify personal or financial information, purchase gift cards, or make other requests for money through email. If something feels strange, please call our office at (763) 473-6968 and ask for confirmation of the request. Here are a few more tips:

- Watch for flags in the tone and grammar. Is the content, tone, and voice of the email/text what you would expect from this person?
- Do not purchase gift cards, give out personal information, or click on any strange links.
- If you're in doubt, ask! Call the church office to confirm any requests.

Sunday, November 2, when 2 am becomes 1 am. Don't forget to set your clocks back before going to bed Saturday night.

Next week, November 2, we will observe **All Saints Sunday** at Messiah and remember loved ones who have gone before us. At both the 8:45 and 10:30 services, we will mention by name the members of our Messiah family who entered the church triumphant in the past year. You will be invited to light a candle before worship in memory of those you have lost and hold dear.

This November, our whole church is joining together in The Wesley Prayer Challenge. The Wesley Covenant Prayer has been used in Methodist services around the world on the first Sunday of the year since John Wesley introduced it in 1755. It begins, "I am no longer my own but thine. Put me to what thou wilt, rank me with whom thou wilt." Wesley expected that people would pray this prayer as a way of remembering, renewing, and surrendering themselves in complete trust to God. We'll be exploring the prayer through the November sermon series and a

companion study. If you're already part of a Faith Group, you'll likely be engaging with this study in your group. If you're not currently in a group, you're invited to follow along on your own! Each day's reading from Chris Folmsbee's 21-day devotional includes scripture, a reflection, and a practical challenge to help you live out the words of the prayer. Christmas Shoeboxes (in partnership with Spirit Lake Ministry Center) are packed with love for children on reservations in the Dakotas and Minnesota. On these reservations, up to 70% of the children would not receive gifts if not for this program and your generosity. Can you help? To start, get a shoebox (or two) and wrap the top and bottom of the box separately with holiday paper OR pack your gift in a clear plastic shoebox. Then start with a "wow" toy, and fill in with other smaller age-appropriate gifts.
