Today we receive **Communion** both in person and online. At Messiah, we practice open communion; all are invited to the Lord's table regardless of age, denomination, or ability. If you need the elements to be brought to you at your seat, please let an usher know. If you prefer not to be served, please take this time for reflection and prayer. To participate at home, be prepared with your own bread and a cup of juice or water.

At Messiah, we love walking with children and youth on their journeys to follow Jesus. To do that, we offer several Sunday morning classes: Children in pre-K through 5th grade gather for KID Street Sunday School during worship. Kids begin in worship, are released to Sunday School mid-service, and will return for communion with their families. Youth in grades 6-8 are encouraged to worship with their families today. Nursery care is available during worship for infants and toddlers (through age 3). Children can be dropped off downstairs in the KID Street HQ before worship begins. All children and youth are always welcome to remain in the sanctuary if your family prefers to worship together.

We're not bothered by wiggles or noise! If it's helpful, "busy bags" are available at the back of the sanctuary, and worship is streaming in the atrium and Heritage Hall. Ushers are happy to help guide you.

An **induction hearing loop** is available in our sanctuary for those with t-coil hearing aids or cochlear implants.

Just a reminder that Messiah Church follows the winter weather closings of the Wayzata School **District.** If Wayzata Schools are closed or school district activities are canceled because of weather. Messiah will also be closed and all events canceled. We will do our best to communicate these changes — please check our website and social media for updates, watch local TV for Wayzata School closings, or call the church office at (763) 473-6968 if you are unsure about your event. As always, please use your best judgment driving in any winter weather. Worship is always available to stream online, from the comfort of your home, at MessiahChurch.org/live.

On Sunday, January 18, join us for a special day of Worship & Service in honor of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. We'll gather for ONE combined worship service at 9:30 am and come together to pack meals with Harvest Pack, an organization that addresses food insecurity through meal-packing events. Our goal is to pack 16,500 fortified oatmeal meals that will be distributed to support those in need right here in our community. Visit tinyurl.com/ HarvestPack2026 to sign up for a 45-minute shift to pack meals either BEFORE or AFTER worship. We'll have two stations set up one UPSTAIRS in Heritage Hall and one DOWNSTAIRS in the Lakeside Room. (This event is similar to packing meals at Feed My Starving Children — involves standing and measuring ingredients into bags; some seated jobs are also available). Feel free to sign up for

more than one shift. (Sign ups help us plan, though walk-ins are also welcome as space permits.) Note: Shifts after worship may be longer than 45 minutes; we will continue until finished — please stay as long as you are able. This is a familyfriendly event — children as young as 3 are welcome to participate! Please note the special worship time and invite others to join us for this meaningful day as we honor Dr. King's legacy of community, justice, and compassion.
