We're worshiping together all summer! Through Sunday, August 31, we will unite for ONE blended worship service at 9:30 am.

At Messiah, we love walking with children and youth on their journeys to follow Jesus. To do that, we offer several Sunday morning classes: Children in pre-K through 5th grade gather for KID Street Sunday School during worship. Kids begin in worship, are released to Sunday School mid-service, and may be picked up downstairs in KID Street Headquarters when worship is over. Sunday School for youth in grades **6-8** is on break until school begins in the fall; youth are encouraged to worship with their families. The nursery, for infants and toddlers (through age 3), is also available, and these children may be dropped off downstairs in the KID Street HQ before worship begins. Children are always welcome to remain in the sanctuary if your family prefers to worship together.

For those with t-coil equipped hearing aids or cochlear implants, an **induction hearing loop** is installed for use in our sanctuary.
