At Messiah, we love walking with children and youth on their journeys to follow Jesus. To do that, we offer several Sunday morning classes: Children in pre-K through 5th grade gather for KID Street Sunday School during worship. Kids begin in worship, are released to Sunday School mid-service, and can be picked up downstairs after worship. Youth in grades 6-8 gather in the Youth Room for Sunday School during both the 8:45 and 10:30 am worship services. Youth begin in worship and are dismissed with the kids mid-service. All children and youth are always welcome to remain in the sanctuary if your family prefers to worship together.

Nursery care is available during worship for infants and toddlers (through age 3). Children can be dropped off downstairs in the KID Street HQ before worship begins. Prefer to keep your little one with you? We're not bothered by wiggles or noise! If it's helpful, "busy bags" are available at the back of the sanctuary, and worship is streaming in the atrium and Heritage Hall. Ushers are happy to help guide you.

An **induction hearing loop** is available in our sanctuary for those with t-coil hearing aids or cochlear implants.

Due to the recent government shutdown, millions of Supplemental **Nutrition Assistance Program** (SNAP) recipients are not receiving their benefits. In response to this need, Messiah has launched an **Emergency Food Drive** to support local families facing food insecurity. We will continue this effort until SNAP Benefits are reinstated and the need for emergency assistance has passed. You can help in three meaningful ways:

- Donate grocery gift cards. Gift cards to Aldi, Cub, or Hy-Vee will be distributed to Bloom Child Care families as needed. Please write the dollar value directly on the card. Gift cards can be dropped off in the offering box on Sundays or in the church office during office hours (Monday-Thursday 9 am-4 pm). To avoid scams, NEVER email gift cards to the church.
- Donate non-perishable food. Most needed items this week are: sugar, vegetable oil (24 oz.), canned chicken, hearty soups (cans), and spaghetti sauce (jars). Food donations can be dropped off in the round marked bins in the atrium on Sundays or during church office hours (Monday-Thursday 9 am-4 pm) and Messiah volunteers will deliver your donation. OR drop off your donation directly at Interfaith Outreach (1605 County Road 101 N, Plymouth) or ICA Food Shelf (11588 K-Tel Dr, Minnetonka) during their donation hours — visit their websites for donation hours. Together, we will do our part to ensure no one in our community goes hungry during this time.
