



Abel means "vain or empty"





SIN'S PATH CARRIES ATTITUDE OF INDIFFERENCE

Woe to them! For they have traveled in the way of Cain, have abandoned themselves to the error of Balaam for profit, and have perished in Korah's rebellion.



For this is the message you have heard from the beginning: We should love one another, unlike Cain, who was of the evil one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him?
