OBEY GOD-DEFY TYRANTS #4

I. Introduction

God's word to the church right now is the subject of our sermon series...

Obey God; Defy Tyrants.

Last week we looked at 'The Tyrannical Nature of Ungodly Government', a teaching taken from the story of the building of Babylon in Genesis 11.

We showed how all the elements in the building of Babylon, the first tyrannical government, can be found in all tyrannical governments ever since, and are now emerging in America. Here's how you know tyrannical governments are rising:

Characteristics of Tyrannical Government

- Offers people political salvation; a heaven on earth—but without God.
- Controls the people by requiring conformity.
- Controls the culture by controlling the language.

Theme

Tyrannical governments use the power of language to control people; it is a device as old as the demonically-inspired building of Babylon in Genesis 11. And it's being done again in our day.

With that in mind, my title for tonight's teaching is a deeper dive into...

"The Power of Language"

Remember, it was God Himself recognized Nimrod's ability to build Babylon was based on language; God's judgment upon them was to confuse their language! Many Christians cannot comprehend how much culture is controlled by language.

John Locke, the famous English philosopher of the Enlightenment said...

John Locke

"Language is the great bond that holds society together."

Leslie Crocker Snyder, is an American lawyer who worked in the New York criminal justice system for over thirty-five years, both as a prosecutor and as a judge. She said this in her 1980 essay, "The Corruption of Language":

Leslie Snyder

Language is the common conduit whereby knowledge is conveyed from one man and one generation to another. It accomplishes this crucial task by enabling us to record our own thoughts and to communicate with others.

Today we are witnessing a corruption of our language, effectively destroying the bond that holds society together. There are several reasons for this, but all of them have a common goal—as John Locke put it--"to darken truth and unsettle people's rights".

 - A. The Biblical Basis for the Power of Language
- 1. The God of the Bible is a *speaking* God! He created all things by speaking words!
 - a. 8 times in Genesis 1, we read, "And God said", and it was done.

Psalm 33:6

By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth.

2. One of the primary names of the Son of God is the Word of God...

John 1:1,14

In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us...

a. The writer of Hebrews tells us in the former days, God spoke to His people through the prophets, but...

Hebrews 1:1-3

In these last days God has spoken to us by His Son...through whom He made the worlds...who upholds all things by the word of His power...

- b. God not only created all things by the spoken word, He 'upholds all things by the word of His power.
- 3. Remember, God made man in His own image and likeness; He made mankind superior to the rest of His creatures by giving us the gift of language; something not given to the lesser creatures. What is 'language'?

Language

The principal method of human communication, consisting of words used in a structured and conventional way and conveyed by speaking or writing.

Language consists of words, to which meaning is attached.

a. Leslie Snyder says we spend too little time thinking about it.

Leslie Snyder, "The Corruption of Language" 1980

To appreciate the crucial and indispensable task that language performs, one needs only to understand what language is and how it functions; that is, language is primarily a tool of cognition.

Leslie Snyder, "The Corruption of Language" 1980

It provides us with a system of classifying and organizing knowledge. It enables us to acquire knowledge on an unlimited scale and to keep order in our minds, which means, enables us to think. The principal consequence of language is communication.

4. But it's more than that...Jesus said that the words we speak communicate the condition of our heart.

Luke 6:45

A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart brings forth evil. For out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks.

5. The Bible testifies to the power of our words in the most powerful terms we can imagine.

Proverbs 18:20

Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruit. (NKJV)

- You will have to live with the consequences of everything you say. What
 you say can preserve life or destroy it; so you must accept the
 consequences of your words. (TEV)
- People will be rewarded for what they say; they will be rewarded by how they speak. (NCV)
 - 6. Language, speaking words, is an essential element of our salvation.

Romans 10:9

if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

- a. Be careful: Paul doesn't mean that just saying the words will save us; we are saved by faith; when the words from our mouth match the faith in our heart.
 - b. And Jesus warned us how much words will matter on the Day of Judgment:

Matthew 12:36-37

But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.

7. So that's point #1: the Bible constantly confirms the power of language; so how come Christians can't comprehend how the tyrants are taking our weapons and using them against us?

8. Christians are losing the culture wars by conceding the power of language into the hands of tyrants, who...

B. Second: Tyrants Control the Culture by Controlling the Language

1. English novelist Angela Carter once commented on how culture is shaped by language:

Angela Carter, English novelist Language is power, life, and the instrument of culture; language is the instrument of domination or liberation.

- a. The power of language can take a culture toward domination or liberation.
- 2. I recommend the writings and website of Kay Rubacek, who survived a prison term in Communist China for participating in the protest in Tiananmen Square in 2001. She says this in her book, "Nowhere Left to Run":

Deception and confusion are critical for tyrannists to be successful at manipulating minds. So they use proven psychological techniques and methods to manipulate words and their meaning. They cleverly and intentionally twist and turn the meanings of words. They rewrite accounts of history and redefine dictionary meanings.

They use the monopolized media mouthpieces to repeat the new definitions over and over again until you accept them and start to repeat them yourself. But it's confusing. The words you thought meant one thing, now don't mean what you thought they meant. Were you wrong before? Who changed the rules?

I remember when 'gay' meant 'lighthearted and carefree'
When marriage meant one man with one woman
When parents were called Mom and Dad and equality meant equality

2. But the modern day American tyrants have hijacked the English language with "Wokeism" and a redefinition of words to the point where many don't know what the words mean anymore. Basic words...like 'Mother'.

The 'Woke' left's hijacking of language deserves ridicule. On Mother's Day, the woke left, always eager to pander to the transgender lobby—have taken to calling mothers by the gender-neutral term 'birthing people'.

Placating the mob has led to the rise in dangerous euphemisms like 'genderaffirming care', a phrase that means the exact opposite of what it claims. In today's world, 'gender-affirming therapy' means telling a girl she can be transformed into a boy, but 'conversion therapy' means telling a girl she's a girl.

The word "freedom" has also been perverted. It once meant to be free from political oppression. Now it means freedom from wants and needs—from hunger, unemployment, sickness, illiteracy, old-age worries, and the like. The

question to ask here is, at whose expense? Then it becomes obvious that these new freedoms are at someone's expense, and are not really freedoms, just irresponsible promises by government.

3.We've gone from euphemisms to political correctness to wokeness.

C. The Christian Response to Language Control: Defy the Tyrants!

Tyrannists know that language is extremely powerful and they use it to their advantage. Good citizens should also understand its power and we should also use it to our advantage.

Language defines a culture. If we allow our language to become perverted, the culture will follow. Language represents thoughts and actions. Use your language to represent your values, your thoughts and your actions.

Don't fall for confusion in language. Don't accept manipulated meanings. Don't be duped into thinking you aren't smart enough to understand the definition.
