I. Introduction

Walking in Truth in a World of Lies

I want to conclude our little mini-series on 'Walking in Truth in a World of Lies' with a famous text from the Lord Jesus...

John 8:32

And you shall know the truth and the truth shall make you free...

My title for tonight adds a thought

"The Truth Shall Make You Free"
(But First It Will Make You Miserable)

There is a truth about the Truth that's often overlooked.

This is something God graced me to learn early on in my walk with the Lord:

Bob Mumford

Truth, at its first appearance, will often seem negative.

The truth can cut like a knife. Listen to what Jesus said to the Pharisees...

John 8:44-45

You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do.
When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it. But because I tell the truth, you do not believe Me.

(It's not a stretch to say that telling the truth put Jesus on the Cross!)

Truth makes men miserable when it corrects their errors, like Paul in Galatia:

Galatians 4:16 NLT

Have I now become your enemy because I am telling you the truth?

(Testimony: I've lost many a member because I told a truth they didn't like)

Telling the truth will always make some men men miserable.

Ask former U.S. Presidents. It was President James Garfield who first said...

President James A. Garfield

The truth will make you free; but first it will make you miserable.

After WWII, President Harry Truman was the Donald Trump of his day; he was known for his confrontive style and they called him, "Give 'em hell Harry')

President Harry Truman

I never give them hell. I just tell the truth and they think it's hell.

One President told us the difference between liberals and conservatives...

President Theodore Roosevelt

If you want to make a conservative angry, lie to him. If you want to make a liberal angry, tell him the truth.

By the way, this is true to this day!

The truth that makes us miserable is that America has become a land of liars; we are like Israel in the days of the Prophets Isaiah and Jeremiah.

Jeremiah 7:28-29

So you shall say to them, 'This is a nation that does not obey the voice of the Lord their God nor receive correction. Truth has perished and has been cut off from their mouth.'

Isaiah 59:4

No one calls for justice, nor does any plead for truth. They trust in empty words and speak lies; they conceive evil and bring forth iniquity.

Isaiah 59:14-15

Justice is turned back, and righteousness stands afar off; for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter. So truth fails, and he who departs from evil makes himself a prey.

Yes, truth is gone, and anyone who renounces evil is attacked.

The is the Old Testament version of our modern 'cancel culture'; to speak the truth in a land of liars puts a target on your back.

II. A Painful Principle To Remember

A. The Truth That Makes Us Miserable About the Church

1. People tend to take for truth whatever agrees with what they want to believe; I'm sad to say this is true in the church as well as in the world.

Satan's greatest asset in his efforts to influence and deceive is that he understands what people want to hear; their ears are wide open to anything that supports, encourages, and helps them achieve their cherished desires. People are only vulnerable to being deceived when they want what is being offered to them.

2. People seek a preacher who tells them what they want to hear; this is a sure sign we're living in the last days

2 Timothy 4:3-4

For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables.

2 Timothy 4:3-5 HCSB

...according to their own desires, they will accumulate teachers for themselves because they have an itch to hear something new. They will turn away from hearing the truth and will turn aside to myths.

2 Tim 4:3-4 NLT

They will follow their own desires and will look for teachers who will tell them whatever their itching ears want to hear. They will reject the truth and chase after myths.

Paul could see the day coming when people would contort the fundamental beliefs of the Church into a new collective mindset dictated by their emotions and desires. Nihilism

The rejection of all religious and moral principles; the belief that life is meaningless

Nihilism is the belief that all values are baseless and that nothing can be known or communicated. It is often associated with extreme pessimism and a radical skepticism that condemns existence. A true nihilist would believe in nothing, have no loyalties, and no purpose other than, perhaps, an impulse to destroy.

Nihilism was popularized by Friedrich Nietzsche, the 19th century German philosopher who proposed that existence is meaningless, moral codes worthless, and God is dead.

An example of nihilism is the desire for the complete rejection of the established order or social system and religious principles.

The nihilist says, 'there is no God, no heaven or hell, nothing is absolutely right or wrong.

Nihilists don't think we live in a reality with a meaning of life set in stone by the Creator.

A good way to deal with nihilism would be to contrast it with the diametrically opposite possibility; a situation where there is perfect meaning to life, with perfect happiness, no sorrow or injustice, and where the progress of nature ensures this in every way.

Nihilism is a belief which rejects all political and religious authority and current ideas in favor of the individual.

Truth is that which is consistent with the mind, will, character, glory, and being of God. Even more to the point: Truth is the self-expression of God. That is the biblical meaning of truth. Because the definition of truth flows from God, truth is theological.

Truth is also *ontological*—which is a fancy way of saying it is the way things really are. Reality is what it is because God declared it so and made it so. Therefore God is the author, source, determiner, governor, arbiter, ultimate standard, and final judge of all truth.

The Old Testament refers to the Almighty as the "God of truth" (Deuteronomy 32:4; Psalm 31:5; Isaiah 65:16). When Jesus said of Himself, "I am...the truth" (John 14:6, emphasis added), He was thereby making a profound claim about His own deity. He was also making it clear that all truth must ultimately be defined in terms of God and His eternal glory. After all, Jesus is "the brightness of [God's] glory and the express image of His person" (Hebrews 1:3). He is truth incarnate—the perfect expression of God and therefore the absolute embodiment of all that is true.

Jesus also said that the written Word of God is truth. It does not merely contain nuggets of truth; it *is* pure, unchangeable, and inviolable truth that (according to Jesus) "cannot be broken" (<u>John 10:35</u>). Praying to His heavenly Father on behalf of His disciples, He said this: "Sanctify them by Your truth. Your word is truth" (<u>John 17:17</u>). Moreover, the Word of God is eternal truth "which lives and abides forever" (<u>1 Peter 1:23</u>).

To do the things which the devil desires is to oppose truth and to increase sin and misery.

"I'm not religious. I'm an atheist" is a common statement today but it is at heart an oxymoron. While atheism does not look like Christianity or Islam, the two largest religions in the world, atheism is a religion. While it is true that atheists do not believe in God, that does not mean that they are not religious.

In daily conversation, atheism is equated with other religions. When asked, "Are you a Christian?", most atheists will respond, "No, I'm an atheist". Atheist Atheist, then, becomes a religious label just like "No, I'm a Buddhist." Atheists also evangelize, though they do not want to use that word to describe their conversion attempts. "Evangelize" is most commonly used in relationship to Christianity, but it can be used to describe other religion's attempts to gain converts, and atheism aggressively seeks to create new converts. Many atheists feel a sense of obligation or desire to "open people's eyes" to what they see as the folly of other religions. There is no difference between an atheist attempting to get a Jew to admit there is no God and a Christian seeking to get a Hindu to denounce the idea of reincarnation. Both people are trying to convert a person from one belief system to another. Atheists' conversion attempts are also blatantly religious because they are focused on beliefs about and in God

The most common misconception that keeps people from correctly labeling atheism a religion is the idea that religion is confined to beliefs in God, not beliefs about God or the actions taken as a result of those beliefs. Were religion merely beliefs in God, then Christianity, Islam and Judaism would technically be the same religion, and no one with any sense is going to argue that those three are actually one religion. As such, perhaps it is time that the list of major world religions is expanded to include the latest serious player on the religious stage: atheism.

Many wish to maintain that the State must be religiously and morally neutral. The Bible makes no such suggestion. Even our Constitution assumes the protection of the Christian religion. The First Amendment had the specific purpose of excluding all rivalry among Christian denominations. Paul expected even the Roman civil government to protect him from those who threatened the Christian religion (Acts 23: 12—31; cf. 25: 11). This means civil government cannot be religiously neutral. If the Christian religion is not defended, then some other religion will be, usually a State religion that degenerates into secularism. The State cannot be neutral toward all religions because all religious views or philosophies necessarily entail uncompromising moral systems, and this guarantees conflict with those of other religious systems. If the State were truly "neutral," it would enact no laws, for each law would penalize someone's religion or religious view or religious practice.

Francis P. Miller, "What is the Chief End of Man?", May 26, 1947 his mind illumined by faith can discern that human existence has significance and that God intends man to have a destiny both in *this* world and in the world to come.

It is precisely at this point that modern Protestantism is weakest and most vulnerable.
