Ecclesiastes 11:10 (NIV®)

¹⁰ So then, banish anxiety from your heart and cast off the troubles of your body, for youth and vigor are meaningless.

I. Truth for Living

A. Loyalty/Faith/Faithfulness

Hebrews 11:6 (NIV®)

⁶ And **without faith it is impossible to please God**, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

2 Timothy 1:11-12 (NIV®)

¹¹ And of this gospel I was appointed a herald and an apostle and a teacher. ¹² That is why I am suffering as I am. Yet I am not ashamed, because **I know whom I have believed**, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him for that day.

B. Friendship

Luke 22:31-34 (NIV®)

³¹ "Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift you as wheat. ³² But I have prayed for you, Simon, that your faith may not fail. And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers." ³³ But he replied, "Lord, I am ready to go with you to prison and to death." ³⁴ Jesus answered, "I tell you, Peter, before the rooster crows today, you will deny three times that you know me."

C. Commitment

Romans 12:1-2 (NIV®)

¹ Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to **offer your bodies as living sacrifices**, holy and pleasing to God--this is your spiritual act of worship. ² Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind.

Luke 16:13-14 (NIV®)

¹³ "**No servant can serve two masters.** Either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and Money." ¹⁴ The Pharisees, who loved money, heard all this and were sneering at Jesus.

1 John 2:17 (NIV®)

²⁵ In the day of great slaughter, **when the towers fall**, streams of water will flow on every high mountain and every lofty hill.

1 Corinthians 7: 31 (NIV®)

For this world in its present form is passing away.

John 6:27 (NIV®)

²⁷ Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. On him God the Father has placed his seal of approval."

Deuteronomy 6:-7 (NIV®)

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 (NIV®)

Titus 2:11-12 (NIV®)
