A Life God Rewards:

Hebrews 11:6 (NIV[®])

⁶ And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that **he rewards those who earnestly seek him**.

Matthew 16:27 (NIV[®])

For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then **he will** reward each person according to what he has done.

I. The Focus of Our Hearts & Minds

Philippians 3:18-20 (NASB®)

¹⁸ For many walk, of whom I often told you, and now tell you even weeping, *that they are* enemies of the cross of Christ, whose end is destruction, whose god is *their* appetite, and *whose* glory is in their shame, **who set their minds on earthly things**. ²⁰ For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ;

Colossians 3:1-2 (NIV®)

¹ Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, **set your hearts on things above**, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. ² **Set your minds on things above**, not on earthly things.

Daniel 10:12 (NIV®)

Then he continued, "Do not be afraid, Daniel. Since the first day that you **set your mind to gain understanding** and to humble yourself before your God, your words were heard, and I have come in response to them."

Matthew 16:23 (NASB®)

²³ But He turned and said to Peter, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are a stumbling block to Me; for **you are not setting your mind on God's interests**, but man's."

¹² In fact, though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk, not solid food! ¹³ Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness.

¹⁴ But solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.
