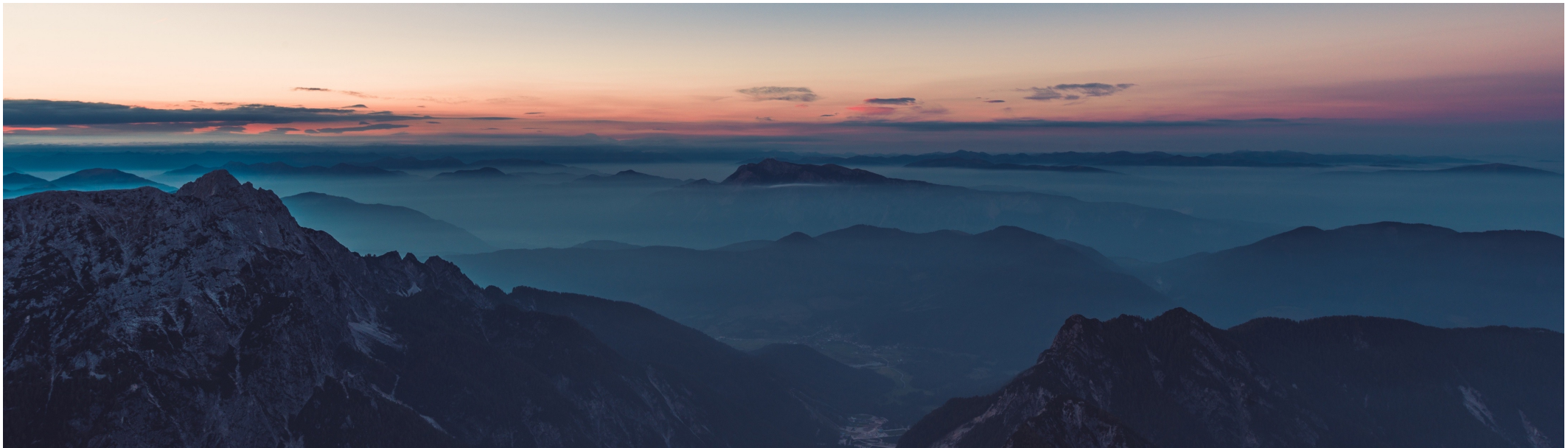


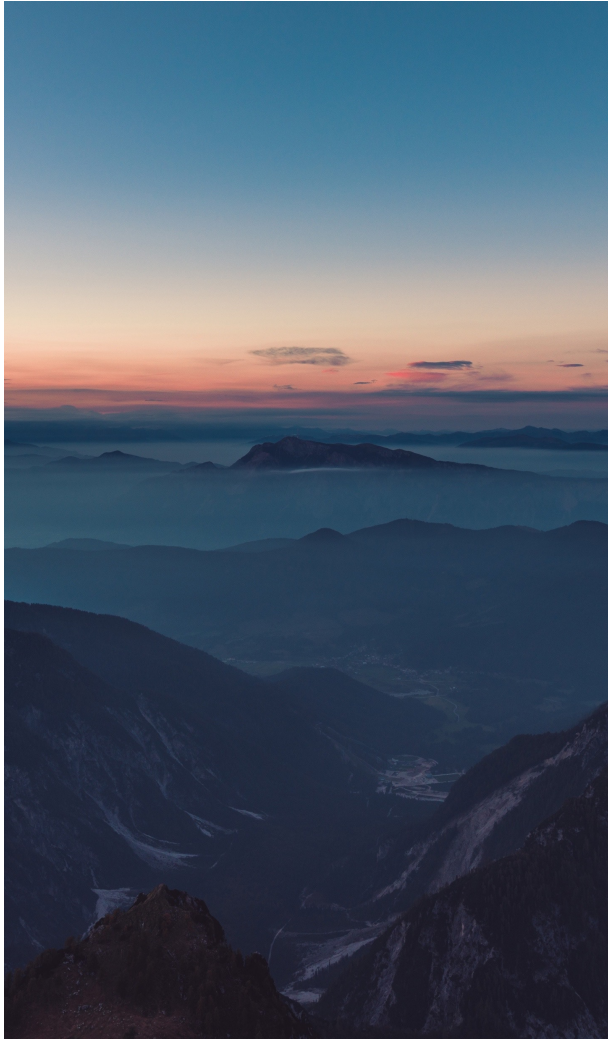


POSSESSING THE LAND

Where to from here? How do I get to where I’m feeling in my spirit the Lord is leading. Our lives must be anchored beyond time but anchored in eternity.



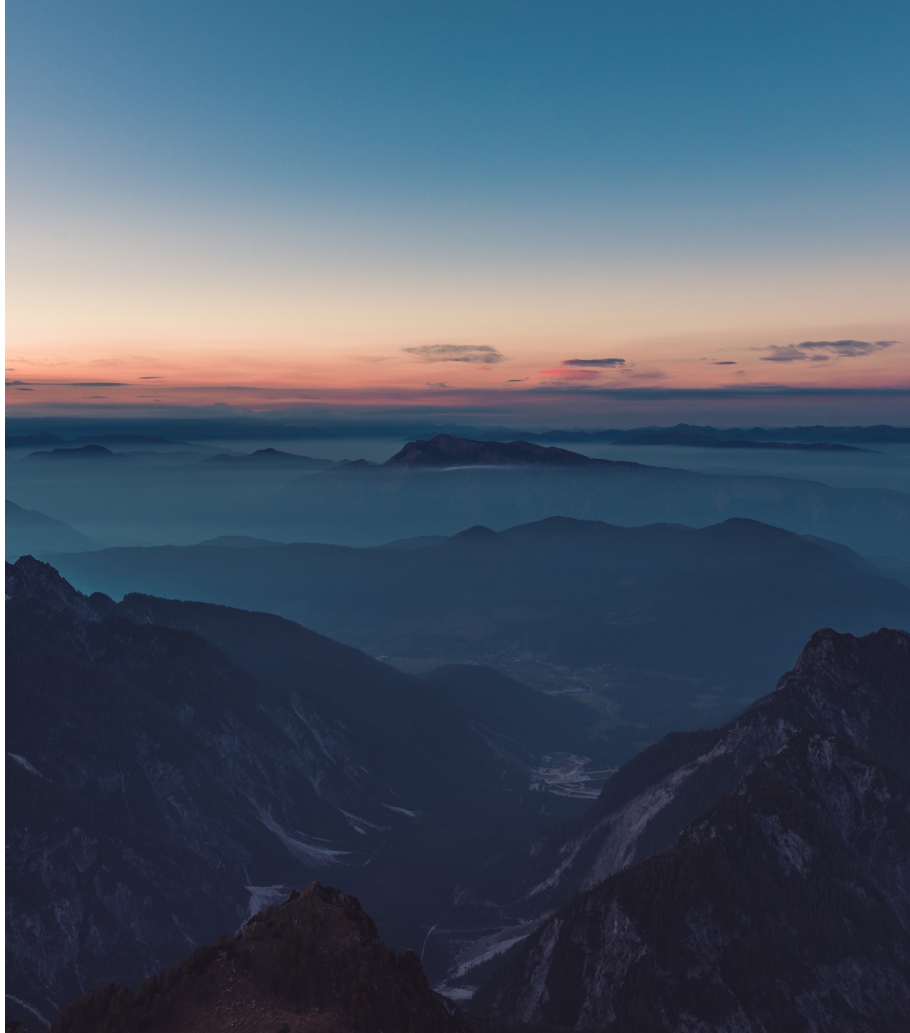

the fruit of life has evolved.**





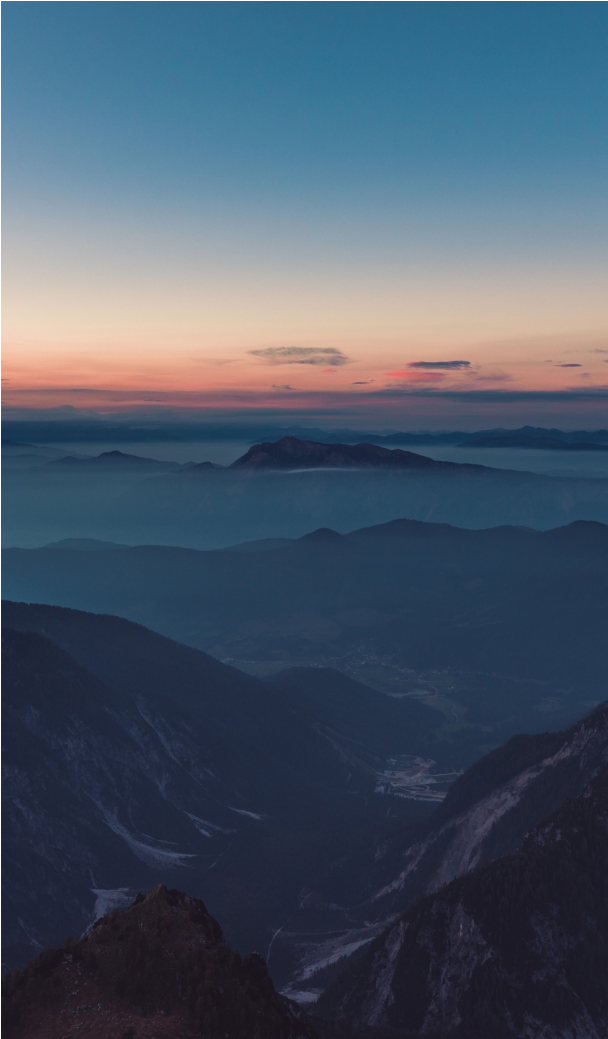

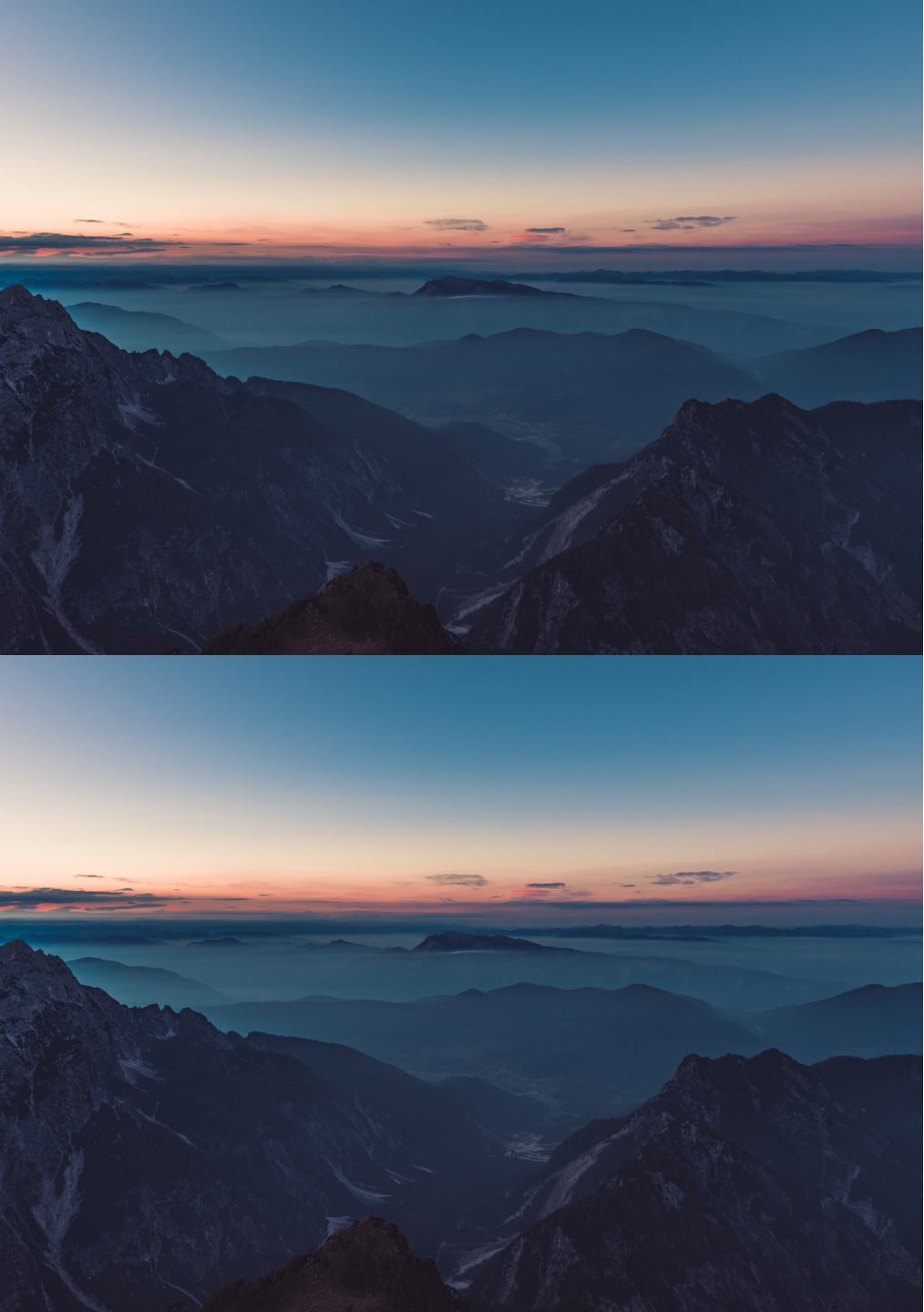

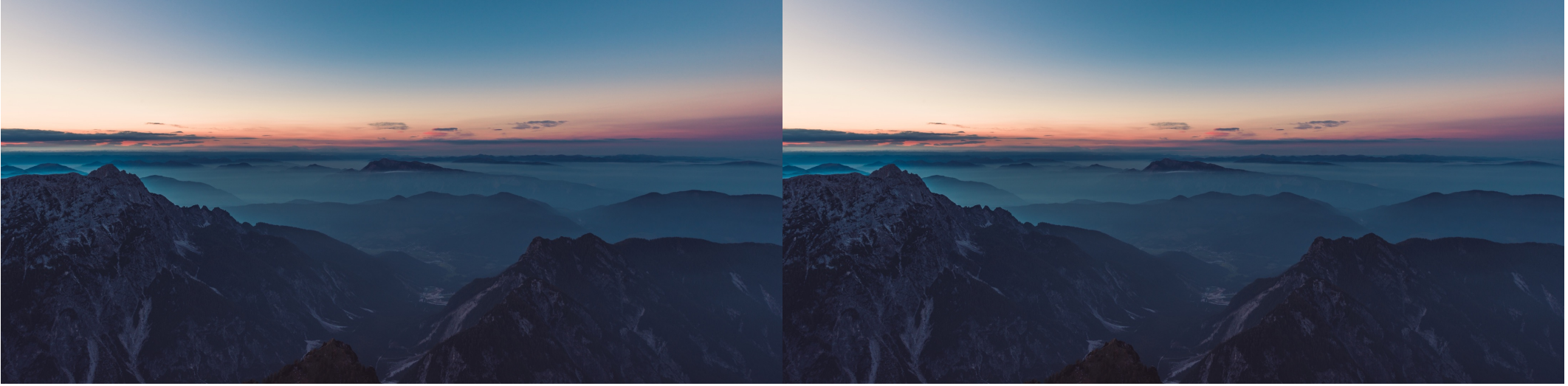

We are simply walking out the **Kairos in our **Chronos** time. We are called to just “sow” and not evaluate the response untimely. Time management deals with Chronos, the Greek word for chronological time. Chronos time is seen as linear and sequential. No second is worth any more than any other second. Chronos is measurable time.**



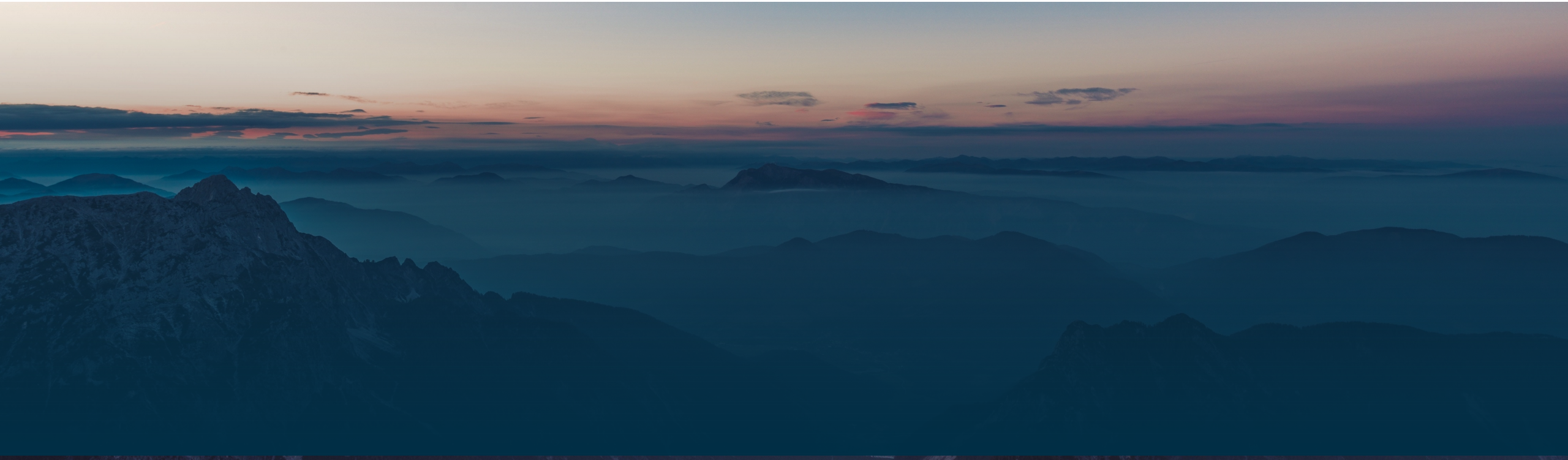
CHRONOS

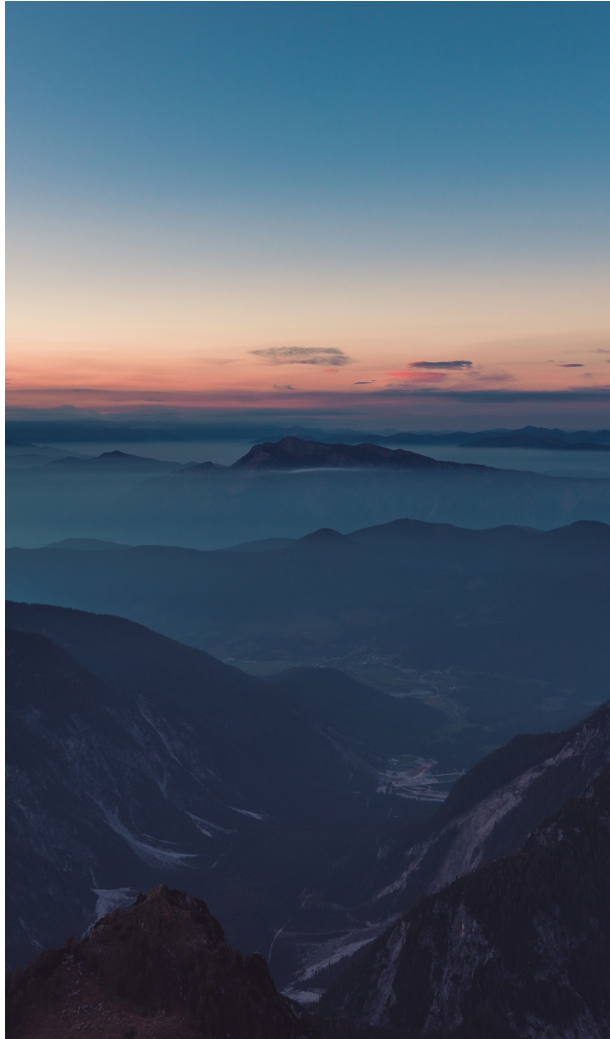
- Chronos can be completed whereas Kairos is eternally evolving.
- Is time in the sense of a period of time; "but when the fullness of Chronos time came ;completed time.
- Can be finished & fixed.
- Can Accomplish its purpose entirely



Kairos time is greatly upon us and calls for active engagement and a change of life. Kairos is the time for the unveiling of fresh revelation. Kairos can be dangerous time. It is critical to recognize it and not respond. If one allows it to pass, the loss can be immeasurable. There is a burden or responsibility tied up in the recognition of the Kairos.

To discern the times, we must first recognize that **the Lord who transacts in time is above time**: He transcends time. He is not a respecter of times and epochs, (period of time marked by notable events) for times and epochs are His instruments and servants. By His sovereign 'kairos' decrees, He changes the natural times of men and epochs of kings just as He desires, without the need to consult men or answer to the natural designs of the times.





The clock essentially dictates the rhythm of our lives. While the compass delivers the destiny of our lives. There are entire cultures in the world that approach life from **Kairos**—an “appropriate opportune time” or “quality time”—a paradigm pregnant with potential. Time is something to be experienced. It’s exponential, of an increase; rising or expanding at a steady, rapid rate. It’s existential; dealing with existence. The essence of Kairos time is how much value you get out of it rather than how much Chronos time you put into it.



Ecclesiastes 3:14-15 AMPC

[14] I know that whatever God does, it endures forever; nothing can be added to it nor anything taken from it. And God does it so that men will [reverently] fear Him [revere and worship Him, knowing that He is].
