How are you waiting?












Place a demand on the very thing GOD HAS DESIGNED for you! It is the will of God that we CALL unto Him and SEEK!




Re-plenish meaning fill based on a demand.






Bartimaeus cried out to Jesus because he was blind. He cried out to the One who could turn his condition around.



Hold God to His promise, as He holds the expectation over you...








Make your petition known?

DO NOT BE LIKE the multitude who gathered. They wanted to just COME SEE ...












How do we ask God to re-plenish?

One sure way is through PRAYER! The prayers of petition are God ordained... Your petitions follow the request God made in His Word

"You did not choose Me, but I chose you and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, that whatever you ask the Father in My name He may give you." (John 15:16, NKJV)

[The word **ask** here in the Greek means *require*]



Your petition releases resources from Heaven itself!


"Don't you realize that I could ask my Father for thousands of angels to protect us, and he would send them instantly?" (Matt 26:53 NLT)





Your BOLD petitions demonstrate your closeness and intimacy with God.

I no longer call you slaves, because a master doesn't confide in his slaves. Now you are my friends, since I have told you everything the Father told me. [16] You didn't choose me. I chose you. I appointed you to go and produce lasting fruit, so that the Father will give you whatever you ask for, using my name. (John 15:15-16 NLT)
