## INTRODUCTION

#### Video: Hidden Figures – Jim Webb

A careful look at the Scriptures proves that Jesus expects His church to have explosive growth – John 15:5, Isaiah 55:8-11. The single purpose of the church is to present the Gospel to the world – Matthew 28: 19-20. It is to carry out the mission of

Jesus – Luke 19:10. Before Jesus went to Calvary,

1) He showed to His disciples the church's potential

- Matthew 9:36. (Multitude) (Harvest)



- 2) He identified those responsible for the harvest (v. 37); His disciples and laborers.
- After the resurrection of Jesus, He then sends church to get His harvest Matthew 28:18-20.
- 50 days after the resurrection then Jesus gives His church (disciples) power to successfully complete the assignment – Acts 1:8. Explosive power for explosive results.

Explosive church growth occurs automatically when the Gospel is the priority of the church – Romans 1:16. The Gospel saves from the penalty of sin, saves from the power of sin, and ultimately from the presence of sin.

But your question is how does that look in our present-day situation? What must we do to get explosive growth in our churches because we have been impacted by the Gospel? The reality is that most of our churches are not getting explosive growth. What adjustments do we need to make? How do we get explosive growth?

## **MY STORY – LUKE 14:15-24**

One Sunday, as I sat in church getting ready to preach, I noticed quite a few empty seats in the sanctuary. Because I have a good idea of where individuals sit, I began to think about who was not at church and began to get angry because I felt they could have been present but chose not to be present because other things claimed their attention that had nothing to do with the Gospel of Jesus Christ.



At that moment, I heard the internal voice of God speak to me and say, "those seats would not be empty if you would go after who I told you to go

get the harvest. He said to read Luke 14 about the great supper. Stop worrying about those who make excuses and go get those with no excuses. Go get those that

I have already gotten ready, and they will gladly come. The Gospel carries relief and solutions. Go get people with problems – Matthew 11:28-30.

When I read Luke 14:21-23, I could not help but compare it to Luke 4:18-19. The two passages were similar:

- Focus on who Jesus focuses on (the poor, lame, brokenhearted, captive, blind, and oppressed).
- Go where Jesus tells us to go (streets, lanes)
  outside the church building in the mainstream
  of life where problems are.




3) Do what Jesus tells us to do (bring them in, compel them to come).

The first response to the Gospel in the book of Acts was explosive growth when the promise in Acts 1:8 was fulfilled in Acts 2. The presence and power of Jesus were magnified through 120 people instantly – Acts 2:1-4.

 The church was filled with the spirit (vs. 4). To have explosive growth, the church must be controlled by the Holy Spirit.

- 2) The church's response got the world's attention (vs. 6-7, 12-13). Verse 4 indicates that they spoke as the Holy Spirit gave them utterance. When we say what Christ directs, the world pays attention.
- The preaching of the Gospel was the answer to the world's confusion. They talked about Jesus only (vs. 22-24, 36).
- 4) The world was convicted by the message of the Gospel (v. 38).
- 5) There was an explosive response to the Gospel, and the church exploded (v. 41).
