2. Where do you need to give up your own way? Is your life about God's agenda or your agenda?

Galatians 5:20, James 3:16, Matthew 16:24

3. Do you have any areas in your life where you think you are indispensable? Where do you think "if I wasn't here, they could never get along"? Do you seek your wisdom or God's Wisdom?

Galatians 6:3, Proverbs 3:5-6, Daniel 4

4. Where is pride destroying relationships in your life?

1 Peter 2:13, Romans 13:1, Philippians 3:8, James 4:7, Matthew 5:3, Isaiah 14:12-14

5. Do you give close attention to the interests of others? Is your focus more on what you need or what others need?

Romans 12:15, Romans 14:19021, Romans 15:1-2, Galatians 6:2

6) Considering all that God has done for me, what is my response to Him? What do I offer in return?

7) What is your "even though"...but I still rejoice? Habakkuk 3:17-18, Romans 15:13
