

Sermon Questions & Verses

The Death of Abraham Genesis 25:1-18

Reflecting on the life of Abraham, use the questions and verses below to challenge yourself to grow and mature in your walk with Christ.

Abraham matured from doubting the promises of God to being so confident in God's promise that he believed Isaac would be resurrected if he was sacrificed. Remember that God's promises are true and will not fail. Here are a few examples of truths and promises spoken from God through His Word to meditate on:

Deuteronomy 31:8; Psalm 103:11-18; Isaiah 53; Joel 2:32; John 3:15-17;
Romans 6:5-11, 8:1; Hebrews 4:14-16

Abraham went from leaning on his own understanding when he would try to work things out with his own plans to leaning his weight completely on the will of God. In doing so, he grew in his knowledge that God was all that he needed. Where are you currently seeking satisfaction other than God?

• Psalm 16:11, 37:4; Matthew 5:6, 6:33; John 6:35. 10:9-10; Philippians 4:11

Early in Abraham's walk with the Lord we saw partial obedience to the things God called him to do. But as he grew in faith, he demonstrated complete obedience. Are you maturing in your faith? Where is God calling you to obey in order that He might grow and mature your faith?
