Wonderful Counselor

Isaiah 9:6

For a child is born to us, a son is given to us.

The government will rest on his shoulders.

And he will be call: Wonderful Counselor, Might God,

Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

1. Scripture describes the word Wonderful exceptional or incomprehensible. When Jesus is called wonderful it means that every part of who he is will cause people to marvel in awe and amazement. Understanding that, are you in awe of who Christ is and what He does?

Luke 1:34-35, Luke 2:14-18, Luke 2:33, Matthew 15:31, Mark 5:42, Mark 2:12, Mark 10:32-34, Mark 15:39, Mark 16:8, Luke 24:30-34, Mark 16:19. Isaiah 53

2. Isaiah describes Christ as a Wonderful Counselor. Meaning that he is the Highest and Most Perfect Teacher. He is the one fit to guide our lives and should be our immediate resource as a counselor. Is Christ your wonderful counselor? Is he your source for all truth, all comfort, all direction?

1 Peter 1:10-12, Colossians 3:16, Zechariah 6:13, Colossians 2:3, Psalm 119:9-11

3. The most wonderful counsel that Christ gives is showing us how to get right with God. Christ says the only way to "solve" our problems is to seek after Him. Are you seeking Christ? Have you done and are you doing what is necessary to get right with God? Is He really all you want in life?
