Before reading the scripture:

What does it mean for the Holy Spirit to fill someone?



Read: Acts 3:1-24

- Jesus walked past the lame man every day on His way to the temple. Why do you think He did not heal the man?
- Perhaps the man did not realise Jesus was walking past because he was looking down, caught in his own despair. Have you ever missed opportunities to encounter Jesus because you were caught up in your own circumstances?
- Peter and John asked the man to look at them. Why?
- Why do you think Peter and John quickly give Jesus all the credit for the healing?
- Is the revelation of Jesus being the Holy and righteous one still fresh in your soul? If not, how can you trust God for a fresh revelation of Jesus in your life?

Works:

(Take some time for personal reflecting on the following questions and then share back with the group)

- How are you challenged to glorify Christ in your school/university/work/home this week?
- How can you practically get better at calling on the Holy Spirit in your life?

Closing:

(Remember to ask for prayer requests.)
