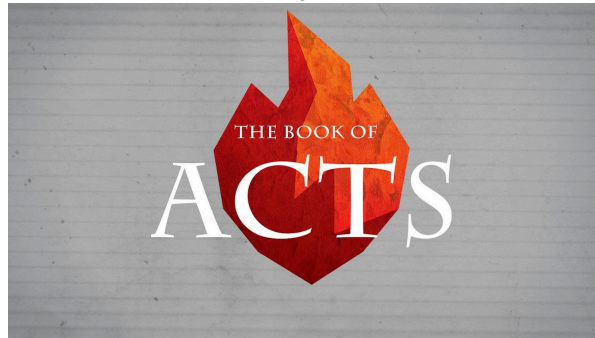


## Connect Group Guide: Acts Part 2 - “The Promise Is For Everyone”

### Welcome:

- Can you name examples from the Old Testament of the Holy Spirit coming upon people? What happened when the Spirit came upon them?
- How would you explain the Holy Spirit to someone who has never heard about Him before?

### Word:

**Before reading the scripture:**

- Why is it significant that the Holy Spirit filled every person that was present in the ‘upper room’?
- Do you believe the Holy Spirit is available to everyone? Why?

- Have you ever experienced the Holy Spirit empowering you to do something that you knew was not possible in your own strength? Please share...

**Read: Acts 2:1-21**

- How does the moment of pentecost fulfill what Joel prophesied about the Spirit?

**Read: Acts 2:22-25**

- God affirms the divinity of Jesus through miracles, wonders and the pouring out of the Holy Spirit to defeat death forever. How can we remind ourselves of the significance of the pouring out of the Holy Spirit?

**Read: Acts 2:36-41**

- Who is “far off” referring to?

**Works:**

***(Take some time for personal reflecting on the following questions and then share back with the group)***

- How can you make the pouring out of the Holy Spirit a reality in your life this week?
- How does the moment of Pentecost 2000 years ago impact you directly today?

**Closing:**

- Pray that the significance of the event of the pentecost that fulfilled a promise would impact our hearts.
