#### Before reading the scripture:

 What does it mean when we say that the Holy Spirit works in and through you?

#### Read: Acts 4:1-20

- Not too long before this event, Peter denied even knowing Jesus, now he boldly proclaims Jesus. What changed?
- Do we need the Holy Spirit when we share the gospel? Why?
- What is your biggest obstacle to sharing the gospel with others?
- It is the same spirit who lived in Jesus, who worked through Peter and John,
  who now works in and through you. Discuss this statement.
- Why do you think there is a resistance to the name of Jesus being proclaimed?
- How does it make you feel knowing that you are the best person to share the gospel to the people that God has placed around you?
- Do you feel like you are able to effectively share the gospel? What would help?

#### Works:

- What is stopping <u>you</u> from proclaiming Jesus?
- In what area of your life is God calling you to surrender to His Spirit and release the Spirit to work in and through you?
- Who has God placed around you to minister to?
