Passage: Acts 10:1-48, Acts 11:13-14

Welcome:

(Choose a question for your group to discuss)

- How will you describe the perfect neighbour?

Worship:

(May choose to use YouTube or other mediums to facilitate your time of worship)

Word:

(Discuss these questions in your group, encourage everyone to take part)

Before reading the scripture:

- Good people aren't necessarily saved. Discuss.

Read: Acts 10:1-8 and Acts 11:13-14

- What was the reason the angel appeared to Cornelius?
- Why wasn't it enough for Cornelius to be a God fearing, a devout person, that gave to the poor and prayed regularly?
- What was the message Peter was meant to bring?

Read: Acts 10:9-23

- Peter was reminded through a vision not to call anything impure or unclean that God has made clean. What was the main message of the vision in your view?
- Do you sometimes see people as unclean, and how does it affect your witness?

Read: Acts 10:34-48

- The moment Peter spoke on how to receive salvation, the Holy Spirit came upon everyone in the room. Why is this significant?
- Everyone was baptised. How is baptism the beginning of our discipleship journey?

Works:

(Take some time for personal reflecting on the following questions and then share back with the group)

- How is God calling you to witness this week?
- How is God calling you to see people?

Closing:

(Remember to ask for prayer requests.)

- Pray for the Holy Spirit to empower you to be an effective witness for Him.
