

Connect Group Guide: “IN.. FOR.. WITH.. - Resurrection Sunday”



Passage: Eph. 1:3-12, Phil. 1:12-21, Rev. 21:1-8

Welcome:

(Choose a question for your group to discuss)

- How did you celebrate Easter as a child?

Worship:

(You may choose to use YouTube or other mediums to facilitate your time of worship)

Word:

(Discuss these questions in your group, encourage everyone to take part)

Before reading the scripture:

- How do you understand the statement: “We are in Christ?”

Read: Ephesians 1:3-12

- Paul says we are chosen in Christ. When? How does this make sense?
- Was every single person chosen in Christ? Why?
- What is the seal that marks us in Christ? Why is this important?

Read: Philippians 1:12-21

- How should the fact that we are in Christ affect our lives?

- Paul even rejoices that Christ is preached for selfish ambition. Have you experienced something like this?
- “For me to live is Christ, to die is gain...” Living Christ, for Christ makes death a gain. Do you fear death?

Read: Revelation 21:1-8

- How does the idea of us, one day living Christ affect your life?
- Please read verse 7 again. How does this make you feel about eternity?

Works:

(Take some time for personal reflecting on the following questions and then share back with the group)

- Do you still try to live for Christ without the full understanding that you are in Christ? How difficult is that?
- How can we get this message of being in Christ across better?
- How do you see yourself living for Christ this week?

Closing:

(Remember to ask for prayer requests.)

Please pray for one another; that we will fully grasp that we are in Christ. Therefore we can live for Christ and be excited that one day we will live with Christ.
