Passage: Acts 21:10-14

Welcome:

(Choose a question for your group to discuss)

- Do you think God calls Christians to do uncomfortable things? Why/why not?
- Have you ever had to decide against someone’s advice for you? How did it turn out?

Word:

(Discuss these questions in your group, encourage everyone to take part)

Before reading the scripture:

- Have you had to do something uncomfortable because you felt God’s prompting? Please share...

Read: Acts 21:10-14

- What does it look like to leave a workplace or a relationship on good terms “when the time is up”?
- Paul went and continued on his journey despite the heartache it caused him and his friends. How does this speak to the importance of hearing God’s voice for big decisions in our lives?

- God's Spirit revealed to Paul that there would be trouble if he left, yet it did not tell Paul to stay put. Why do you think this is?
- "Be careful of people's opinions about God's will for your life." Discuss...
- "If I am not happy with God's plan it cannot be from God." Discuss...
- Do you think it was God's will to allow the early church to get persecuted so that the message of Christ could spread across the globe?

Think of the following 4 ways that God's speaks to us:

- God's Word
- God's Spirit
- Personal Conscience Conviction
- Godly Community
 - Which one of these do you hear God speaking to you clearly & which of these could you incorporate more in your life?

Works:

(Take some time for personal reflecting on the following questions and then share back with the group)

- How can you listen carefully and act promptly to God's voice this week?
- What does it look like in your own life to choose God's will whether it means suffering or not?
- How can you make sure that you are being obedient to God whether He says 'go' or 'stay'?

Closing:

(Remember to ask for prayer requests.)

Pray that we may listen to God's voice carefully and to do His will in our lives.
