Passages: Genesis 28:16, Matthew 27:51, Hebrews 10:19-22 Sermon Link: Oblivious

Welcome:

(Choose a question for your group to discuss)

- Have you ever heard someone ask: "Have you heard what I said?"
- Have you been surprised to learn you have been oblivious?

Worship:

(May choose to use YouTube or other mediums to facilitate your time of worship)

Word:

(Discuss these questions in your group, encourage everyone to take part)

Before reading the scripture:

- Do you find that you are sometimes oblivious to the presence of God?
- Why do you think that is?



Read: Genesis 28:16

- What do you think Jacob was aware of?
- What made Jacob aware of the presence of God?
- How did it impact his life when he became aware of God's presence?

Read: Matthew 27:51 and Hebrews 10:19-22

- What does it mean for you and I that the veil was torn?
- How will it impact your life, knowing you spend 24/7 in the presence of Jesus.

Read: Psalm 13:1-6

- How does David start this psalm? What does it say about honesty with God?
- How does he end the psalm? Do you think this was authentic?
- How can one psalm begin one way and end another?

Works:

(Take some time for personal reflecting on the following questions and then share back with the group)

- What can you do this week to make yourself more aware of the presence of God in your life?
- How do we keep God present in our minds this week?

Closing:

(Remember to ask for prayer requests.)

• Pray that the Holy Spirit will guide you that you will constantly be aware of God's presence.
