

## Connect Group Guide: "Spiritual Sight"

### Welcome:

### Word:

*(Discuss these questions in your group, encourage everyone to take part)*

**Before reading the scripture:**

- What does it mean to see people the way Jesus sees them?
- How would you describe spiritual sight?

**Read: Luke 23:32-43**

- What do you think it was like for Jesus to be crucified?
- Do you think it was easy for Jesus to forgive those that were crucifying him?
- Why do you think Jesus said; "Father forgive them, for they do not know what they are doing"?
- Why is it important to have compassion for those that are spiritually blind?

- How does the knowledge of what Jesus has done on the cross impact the way we treat people?
- How does it encourage you to know how the thief went from mocking Jesus → to **seeing** Jesus for who He truly is → to **comprehending** what that meant for his own sinful life → to confessing his sin in **repentance**.

### Works:

*(Take some time for personal reflecting on the following questions and then share back with the group)*

- In what way can we view people the way Jesus sees them?
- How do you see yourself through the lens of the cross?
- How can you forgive the way Jesus did?

### Closing:

*(Remember to ask for prayer requests.)*

- Pray together and ask that God will light the path that you walk on, that He may open your eyes and allow you to see what He sees. Pray for each other asking God to help us see others the way He sees them.
