Please reach out to a trusted spouse or friend, Missional Community leader, or an elder for additional support.

"Almighty and all-knowing God, Your word states if I lack wisdom, I have only to ask You and You will give generously without finding fault (James 1:5), as such I am asking You to reveal any and all places where I have knowingly or unknowingly given ground to the enemy of my soul, so that I can confess and repent of participation with the father of lies. I desire to live in freedom. Amen."

□ Committing sexual sin (to include pornography, adultery, etc.)
□ Participating in occultic activity (past or present)

□ Participating in non-Christian activities (i.e., seances, magic 8-ball, psychic readings, etc.)
□ Believing lies about God, self, or others
□ Giving into fear
□ Being prideful
□ Being rebellious
\square Using my body for unrighteous (e.g., addictions, self-harm/cutting, abortion, drivenness & perfectionism, feeding my flesh, etc.)
□ Having been influenced by the generational strongholds of my ancestors (e.g., depression, anger, physical/emotional/mental abuse, addiction, financial irresponsibility, compulsions, etc.)
\square Other area(s) that prevent you from walking in your identity as a Christ follower

Prayer:

Lord Jesus, since Your word says if we confess our sins, You are faithful and just to forgive us and cleanse us from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9), I confess and repent of having participated with the enemy by ____(state your specific area of struggle from the list above) ____. Please forgive me. Satan is a liar and deceiver (John 8:44), and I have fallen (knowingly or unknowingly) to his schemes (1 John 1:8). I have stepped out of my true identity as a believer and may have opened a door for him to have access to harass me (1 Peter 5:8, Luke 22:31-32). It is for freedom that Christ has set me free (Gal 5:1), so if the Son sets me free, I am free indeed (John 8:36)! I choose freedom. Thank You for closing the door to the enemy's strategies and distractions. Enable me to stand firm and not submit again to a yoke of slavery; instead I will take Jesus' yoke upon me and will learn from Him for He is gentle and humble of heart. I will find rest for my soul (Matthew 11:29), in Your name I pray, amen.
