Week 7 | CONNECT

You may use this as prayer prompts through the week on your own or pray for them together as you gather as a Missional Community. Either way take notes in how the Spirit may be directing you and your Missional Community to share those challenges and opportunities with one another. (Some repeat this week with more community engagement in mind.)

Acts 2:42-47

42 And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. 43 And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. 44 And all who believed were together and had all things in common. 45 And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. 46 And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, 47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.

Day 1

Pray that we would devote ourselves to Jesus' teaching, to love God and love others.

Day 2

Pray that we (MC) would continue to be devoted to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and prayers.

Day 3

Pray that the Holy Spirit would continue to display signs and wonders among his people to draw outsiders to Jesus.

Day 4

Pray for unity in our diversity and that we would be in the mission of making disciples of all people together and would see our commonality, namely Jesus as our anchor in a diverse body.

Day 5

Pray for continued wisdom and discernment on how to meet each others needs and those in need around our neighborhoods and city.

Day 6

Pray the Spirit would empower us (MC) to continue to meet together for the Sunday Gathering and in our homes in various ways throughout the week for encouragement, edification, and equipping.

Day 7

Pray for us (MC) to have glad and generous hearts when we eat together, worship together and advance the Kingdom together and ask for the Lord to add to our number day by day.
