Week 5 | Identity In Christ

You may use this as prayer prompts through the week on your own or pray for them together as you gather as a Missional Community. Either way take notes in how the Spirit may be directing you and your Missional Community to share those challenges and opportunities with one another. (Some repeat this week with more community engagement in mind.)

Galatians 4:1-7

I mean that the heir, as long as he is a child, is no different from a slave, though he is the owner of everything, but he is under guardians and managers until the date set by his father. In the same way we also, when we were children, were enslaved to the elementary principles of the world. But when the fullness of time had come, God sent forth his Son, born of woman, born under the law, to redeem those who were under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. And because you are sons, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying, "Abba! Father!" So you are no longer a slave, but a son, and if a son, then an heir through God.

Day 1

Pray that we would know that we are adopted into the Family of God.

Day 2

Pray that we would encourage one another in our Sonship and Daughterhood.

Day 3

Pray that our hearts would be broken over our sin that enslaves our hearts and minds and keeps us from walking in the fulness of our Identity in Christ.

Day 4

Pray for a desire to know the Father as "Abba, Father."

Day 5

Pray that God would give you an overwhelming sense of his love for you as his child.

Day 6

Pray the Spirit would confirm in many tangible ways that you are an adopted heir.

Day 7

Pray for us to glorify the Father by making much of His Son Jesus.
