In Deuteronomy 8:2-5, Moses reminds the Israelites of their time in the wilderness and how God tested them to humble them. How can the experiences and trials in our own lives serve as opportunities for spiritual growth and dependence on God?

Verses 10-14 warn about the dangers of becoming proud and forgetting God when we experience prosperity. What strategies can we use to remain humble and grateful when we are blessed with success or abundance

Deuteronomy 8:18 reminds the Israelites that it is God who gives them the ability to produce wealth. How can we better acknowledge and reflect on God's provision in our own lives, especially in the context of our work and resources?
