Scripture: Galatians 1:1-5 [ESV]

Paul, an apostle—not from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised him from the dead— 2 and all the brothers[a] who are with me,

To the churches of Galatia:

3 Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, 4 who gave himself for our sins to deliver us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, 5 to whom be the glory forever and ever. Amen.

One mark of apostolic authority is having been taught directly by Jesus. Paul emphasizes that his
nessage is not from/nor through man, but through Jesus Christ throughout Galatians. Though
uthoritative, Paul also exhibited humility by verifying his message with the "Pillars" of the faith (Gal
:9). Though we do not have apostolic authority, what can we learn from Paul's confidence and humility
when sharing the Gospel with the lost? Who is (and what event is) the backing authority of the Gospel?

Paul distills the Gospel into very simple and powerful terms in verses three and four. Take a moment to discuss each word individually in the following Gospel statement:
"Jesus Christ gave himself for our sins to deliver us from the present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father."
In what ways do we tend to complicate this message by adding to it?
The first question of the <i>Westminster Shorter Catechism</i> is, "What is the chief end of man?" How might you answer this question? How does the Catechism answer this question? How can we live each moment in an effort to fulfill our chief end?

Source of Light Ministries

- SOL started a new branch in Costa Rica. The team in Costa Rica will distribute discipleship courses throughout the country and seek ways to share the Gospel with lost people.
- Four missionaries with SOL went through a support-raising course and are actively raising support. Those missionaries are Brian Thigpen, Bruce Dare, Johnathan Wideman, and Ben Doomy. Pray that God would supply the needed funds for their ministries.
- Ukraine- SOL is running a relief initiative for Ukrainian refugees. Many of these refugees are fleeing into Romania, where SOL is funding a local church that has a summer camp facility. The church is providing housing, food, diapers, beds, clothing and transportation, and information. Pray for these fundraising efforts!
- SOL also just held trainings for directors for three new branches starting in Spain, Mexico, and Peru. Pray for these branches as they distribute discipleship courses and bring the Gospel to lost people.
- New courses- SOL is currently writing new discipleship courses for children! All of their coursework is used worldwide, so praise God for the opportunity for these new materials to open doors for children all over the world to be raised in the knowledge of God!
