Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE

Matthew 21:1-11

SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we'll see how Jesus fulfilled prophecy as He rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. Some people even laid out pieces of clothing and palm branches on the road ahead of Jesus. They praised Him and proclaimed He was the Son of David who came to save. The whole city wanted to know who Jesus really was.

- Jesus is the Messiah who fulfills prophecy (Matthew 21:1-5).
- Jesus is the King who deserves adoration (Matthew 21:6-8).
- Jesus is the Son of David who brings salvation (Matthew 21:9-11).

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- · What's a recent situation we experienced that didn't go the way we expected?
- · How can we, as a family, walk together as we handle unmet expectations?
- How do you experience Jesus in worship? What does it look like to do this as a family, away from the crowds at church? What about individually?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

We can worship God many ways—it doesn't always have to be in church or through music. Here are a few other ideas: listening to sermons or podcasts, talking about good things God has done for us, praying alone, praying with others, serving others, sharing the truth about Jesus on social media or with a friend, and so on. Choose one way you can worship Jesus together as a family and set aside time to do that this week. Consider making this a weekly or monthly tradition.
