Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

## **SCRIPTURE**

John 21:1-6,9-17

## SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we see Jesus reveal Himself to His disciples another time, in another way, after His resurrection. Not only did He show up, but He also restored Peter after his outright denial of knowing Jesus at Jesus's first trial. Then, He gave Peter a new calling to take care of Jesus's people. Here are the main themes:

- The risen Messiah reveals Himself (John 21:1-6).
- The risen Messiah enjoys relationship (John 21:9-14).
- The risen Messiah restores fellowship (John 21:15-17).

## **CONVERSATION QUESTIONS**

- How does our family need Jesus to meet us where we are right now? In what ways has He
  done so in the past?
- · How is Jesus meeting our family's needs right now?
- · Where does our family need Jesus to restore? What might that look like?

## **FAMILY CHALLENGE**

Give each family member several slips of paper and invite them to write each request on separate slips of paper—something they want Jesus to restore in their lives, in our family, in our church, in our community, or in our world. Fold the slips of paper, and place them in a jar or bowl. Each night, draw one request and pray over it together.
