Challenge: Remember in Sunday School how we blindfolded someone and led them safely around the classroom to demonstrate how faith is believing and trusting in God, even though we can't physically see Him? Well, now it is your turn to do this activity with someone in your family or with a friend! Next week, tell us how it went!

1. Ask a family member or friend if you can do an activity about faith with them.
2. Ask them to close their eyes.
3. Tell them, "I will lead you safely around the room. Do you trust and believe me?"
4. Lead them safely around the room.
5. When you are finished, ask them how they felt during the activity.
6. Explain that this activity is similar to the way we have faith in God. Faith means we believe in God and we trust Him with our lives, even though we can't physically see Him.
