YOU CANNOT AND WILL NOT GROW UNLESS YOU ARE RIGHTLY RELATED TO THE WORD OF GOD!



IN ORDER TO BE A DOER OF THE WORD, THERE ARE THREE COMMANDS WE NEED TO EMBRACE

1. You must "Hear the Word" (v19)

2. You must "Receive the Word" (v21)

3. You must "Do (Obey) the Word" (v22)

19 So then, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath; 20 for the wrath of man does not produce the righteousness of God.

THE APPLICATION (VS 26-27)

"26 Those who consider themselves religious (A good Christian) and yet do not keep a tight rein on their tongues deceive themselves, and their religion is worthless. 27 Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself from being polluted by the world."
