1. Conflicts Come from the Quest for Pleasure

Pleasure = Hedonism

desire (feeling) n. — the feeling that accompanies an unsatisfied state.

2. Conflicts Come from Wanting What You Cannot Have

a. Yet you do not have because you do not ask. (4:2)

b. You ask with the wrong motives (4:3)

3. Conflicts Come from Taking the Wrong Side (4:4)

4:4 Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God.

ISAIAH 54:5

"For your Maker is your husband, The Lord of hosts is His name; And your Redeemer is the Holy One of Israel; He is called the God of the whole earth."

2 CORINTHIANS 11:2-3

"2 For I am jealous for you with godly jealousy. For I have betrothed you to one husband, that I may present you as a chaste virgin to Christ. 3 But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the simplicity that is in Christ."

2 CORINTHIANS 6:14-15

"14 Do not be unequally yoked together with unbelievers. For what fellowship has righteousness with lawlessness? And what communion has light with darkness? 15 And what accord has Christ with Belial? Or what part has a believer with an unbeliever?"

4. Conflicts Come from a Lack of Humility (4:6)

(4:6) And he gives grace generously. As the Scriptures say, "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."

PSALIM 138:6

"6 Though the Lord is on high, Yet He regards the lowly; But the proud He knows from afar."

PROVERBS 3:34

"Surely He scorns the scornful, But gives grace to the humble."

ISAIAH 57:15

"For thus says the High and Lofty One, Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy: "I dwell in the high and holy place, with him who has a contrite and humble spirit, To revive the spirit of the humble, and to revive the heart of the contrite ones."

II. The Solution Supplied (from God)

- 1. Therefore submit to God (4:7)
- 2. Resist the devil (4:7)
- 3. Draw near to God (4:8)
- 4. Cleanse your hands (4:8)
- 5. Purify your hearts (4:8)

II. The Solution Supplied (from God) Continued...

- 6. Lament (4:9)
- 7. Mourn (4:9)
- 8. Weep (4:9)
- 9. Let your laughter be turned into mourning, and your joy to gloom (4:9)
- 10. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord (4:10)
