1 Maccabees 1:41-42

41 Then the king wrote to his whole kingdom that all should be one people, 42 and abandon their particular customs. All the Gentiles conformed to the command of the king,

1 Maccabees 1:43-44

43 and many Israelites delighted in his religion; they sacrificed to idols and profaned the sabbath. 44 The king sent letters by messenger to Jerusalem and to the cities of Judah, ordering them to follow customs foreign to their land;

1 Maccabees 1:45-47

45 to prohibit burnt offerings, sacrifices, and libations in the sanctuary, to profane the sabbaths and feast days, 46 to desecrate the sanctuary and the sacred ministers, 47 to build pagan altars and temples and shrines, to sacrifice swine and unclean animals,

1 Maccabees 1:48-50

48 to leave their sons uncircumcised, and to defile themselves with every kind of impurity and abomination; 49 so that they might forget the law and change all its ordinances. 50 Whoever refused to act according to the command of the king was to be put to death.

3 At that the king, in a fury, gave orders to have pans and caldrons heated. 4 These were quickly heated, and he gave the order to cut out the tongue of the one who had spoken for the others, to scalp him and cut off his hands and feet, while the rest of his brothers and his mother looked on.

5 When he was completely maimed but still breathing, the king ordered them to carry him to the fire and fry him. As a cloud of smoke spread from the pan, the brothers and their mother encouraged one another to die nobly, with these words: 6 "The Lord God is looking on and truly has compassion on us, as Moses declared in his song, when he openly bore witness, saying, 'And God will have compassion on his servants.'

In Daniel 8, God gives us an introduction to the Antichrist describing eight (8) characteristics that define this man of evil who will appear on the world stage during the coming tribulation period.

1. HE WILL BE DYNAMIC IN HIS PERSONALITY Daniel 8:23

A king shall arise, having fierce features, who understands sinister schemes.

"The world will go delirious with delight at his manifestation." He will be seeming to answer to all of its needs. He will be filled with all the fullness of Satan. Handsome, with a charming rakish, devil may care personality, a genius, superbly at home in all the scientific disciplines, brave as a lion and with an air of mystery about him, to tease the imagination or to chill the blood, as occasion may serve, a brilliant conversationalist and a score of tongues. He will be the idol of all mankind."

3. HE WILL BE DEVILISH IN HIS POWER Daniel 8:24

His power shall be mighty, but not by his own power;

2 THESSALONIANS 2:9

The coming of the *lawless one* is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs, and lying wonders,

REVELATION 13:2

4. HE WILL BE DESTRUCTIVE IN HIS PERSECUTION Daniel 8:24

7. HE WILL BE DEFEATED IN HIS PURPOSE Daniel 8:25
