“Do to others what you would have them do to you.”

### **{Slide 12} Proverbs 11:17 (NIV)**

Those who are kind benefit themselves but the cruel bring ruin on themselves.

#### **2) Go the second mile. {Slide 13}**

“If anyone forces you to go one mile, go with them two miles.”

### **3) Be gracious. {Slide15}**

All spoke well of him and were amazed at the gracious words that came from his lips.

#### **{Slide 17} Luke 6:37-38a (NIV)**

37 “Do not judge, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn, and you will not be condemned. Forgive, and you will be forgiven. 38 Give, and it will be given to you.”
