



## “The Test: Abraham and Isaac”

**SuperTruth:** Put God first, above all else.

**SuperVerse:** “Faith shows the reality of what we hope for; it is the evidence of things we cannot see.” (Hebrews 11:1)

### Introduction:

### Follow up Questions

2. What choices did Chris have?
3. Do you think God was giving Chris a chance to do something special?

How did God test Abraham?

Why do you think God would ask such a thing?

What did Abraham say when Isaac asked where the sacrifice was? How did God provide for Abraham and Isaac on the mountain?

We can always trust God to provide everything we need. What are some of the things God has provided for you?

### Bible Reading:

When we trust God and do what He asks—even if we don’t understand why—He blesses us!

**Read Hebrews 11:1-6**

What is faith? Did you know that faith pleases God very much?  
What does God promise to give those people that have faith?

**Read Genesis 22:17-18.**

What blessings and rewards did God promise Abraham because he obeyed?

How did Chris feel when he watched the sick boy playing with his new game? Do you think Chris expected to feel so great after giving his game away?

Many years later, one of the people born into Abraham's big family was Jesus. Although He was God's own dear Son and never did anything wrong, God asked Jesus to die on the cross for our sins. Jesus did what His Father asked—and God brought Him back to life! When we trust Him, He forgives our sins and makes us part of His family forever.
