Questions for Reflection

How does Jesus' willingness to sacrifice affect the way you serve others and live today?
How does sacrifice build kinship?

What is Holy or Maundy Thursday? This is the Thursday before Easter. Many churches gather for worship including Holy Communion to remember Jesus' last meal with his disciples before he was arrested, tried and crucified.

Why is it called Good Friday? We remember Jesus' death on the Friday before Easter. It is called Good Friday because it reminds us of God's purpose to love and redeem us by drawing us to God's self through the cross of Jesus Christ.
