3. Look at 2 Cor. 8:6 again. What did Paul mean when he said generosity "completes" grace?
4. Why would generosity be a good way to verify our love?
5. How can we as individuals and as a church strengthen the picture of giving as worship?
6. What are some material possessions that could become idols in your heart?
7. Will we receive a financial return on whatever we give financially (2 Cor. 9:6)? Why or why not?
8. How should the promise that we will always have what we need impact our level of generosity to others?
9. What are some ways you can expand your ability to be generous with others?
10. How is our thankfulness for what we have connected to our level of generosity?
