• God is not a failure and will not fail

## 3 Last week... Maturity - Philippians 1:9-11

9 And it is my prayer that your love may <u>abound more and more</u>, with knowledge and all discernment, 10 so that you may approve what is excellent, and so be pure and blameless for <u>the day of Christ</u>, 11 filled with <u>the fruit of righteousness</u> that comes through Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God.

## 4 Last week... Love - Philippians 1:7-8

7 It is right for me to feel this way about you all, because <u>I hold you in my heart</u>, for you are all partakers <u>with me</u> of grace, both in my imprisonment and in the <u>defense</u> and confirmation of the gospel. 8 For God is my witness, how I yearn for you all with <u>the affection of Christ Jesus</u>.

## 6 1 A Lesson In Providence (1:12)

I want you to know, brothers, that what has happened to me <u>has really served</u> to advance the gospel,

### 7 Q: What are God's works of providence?

A: God's works of providence are, his most holy, wise, and powerful preserving and governing all his creatures and all their actions.

- 1. Psalm 145:17. The Lord is righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works.
- 2. Psalm 104:24. O Lord, how manifold are thy works! in wisdom hast thou made them all: the earth is full of thy riches.
- 3. Hebrews 1:3. Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had by himself purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high.
- 4. Psalm 103:19. The Lord hath prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom ruleth over all.

Matthew 10:29-30. Are not two sparrows sold for a farthing? and one of them shall not fall on the ground without your Father. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Job 38-41.

## 8 2 A Lesson In Progress (1:12-14)

I want you to know, brothers, that what has happened to me has really served to <u>advance</u> the gospel, 13 so that it has become <u>known</u> throughout the whole imperial guard and to all the rest that my imprisonment is for Christ. 14 And most of the brothers, having become <u>confident</u> in the Lord by my imprisonment, are much more <u>bold</u> to speak the word without fear.

The term here rendered "confident" (pepoithotas) means to become "bold" or "fearless." When Paul arrived in Rome in chains, many Christians were likely paralyzed by the fear of a tsunami of persecution that might be coming, but when they saw the power of his witness and its effects on the Roman elite they must have thought, "If he can do this while on trial for his life, how much more should we be able to accomplish."

# 10 3 A Lesson In Purpose (1:15-18)

15 Some indeed preach Christ from envy and rivalry, but others from good will. 16 The latter do it out of love, knowing that <u>I am put here</u> for the defense of the gospel. 17 The former proclaim Christ out of selfish ambition, not sincerely but thinking to afflict me in my imprisonment. 18 What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, <u>Christ is proclaimed</u>, and in that I rejoice.

- 1. God's plan is probably different than yours... even if you follow Him.
- 2. The 'Word' is probably more important than you think it is.
- 3. Having a bad season? Wait on God and follow Christ in the Gospel and you will find new joy.
