A Call to Repentance by Contemporary Prophets of Isaiah

Prophet	Era	Recipients of the prophesy	Message
Amos	755-754 B.C.	Northern Kingdom, Israel – Leaders and Unjust wealthy	I will stir up a nation against you. Am 6:14
Hosea	752-720 B.C.	Northern Kingdom, Israel	Israel breaks her Covenant with God. Judgment: drought, invasion, and plundering. Hos 13:14-16
Isaiah	740-681 B.C	Judah, specifically Jerusalem (Southern). But also Israel (Northern).	Their tongue and their doings are against the Lord. Isa 3:8. They will be devoured by the sword.
Jeremiah	608 B.C.	Judah, specifically Jerusalem (Southern).	They are idolatrous and unjust: they will reap destruction and exile. Jer 11:6-8



Isa 6:1 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple.

Isa 6:2 Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew.

Isa 6:3 And one cried to another and said: "Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts; The whole earth is full of His glory!"

Isa 6:4 And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke.



Isa 6:5 So I said: "Woe *is* me, for I am undone! Because I *am* a man of unclean lips, And I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, The LORD of hosts."

Isa 6:6 Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal *which* he had taken with the tongs from the altar.

Isa 6:7 And he touched my mouth *with it*, and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; Your iniquity is taken away, And your sin purged."

Isa 6:8 Also I heard the voice of the Lord,
saying: "Whom shall I send, And who will go
for Us?" Then I said, "Here *am* I! Send me."

Isa 6:9 And He said, "Go, and tell this
people: 'Keep on hearing, but do not
understand; Keep on seeing, but do not
perceive.'

Isa 6:10 "Make the heart of this people dull,
And their ears heavy, And shut their eyes;
Lest they see with their eyes, And hear with
their ears, And understand with their heart,
And return and be healed."



Isa 6:11 Then I said, "Lord, how long?" And He answered: "Until the cities are laid waste and without inhabitants, The houses are without a man, The land is utterly desolate,

Isa 6:12 The LORD has removed men far away, And the forsaken places are many in the midst of the land.

Isa 6:13 But yet a tenth will be in it, And will return and be for consuming, As a terebinth tree or as an oak, Whose stump remains when it is cut down. So the holy seed shall be its stump."
