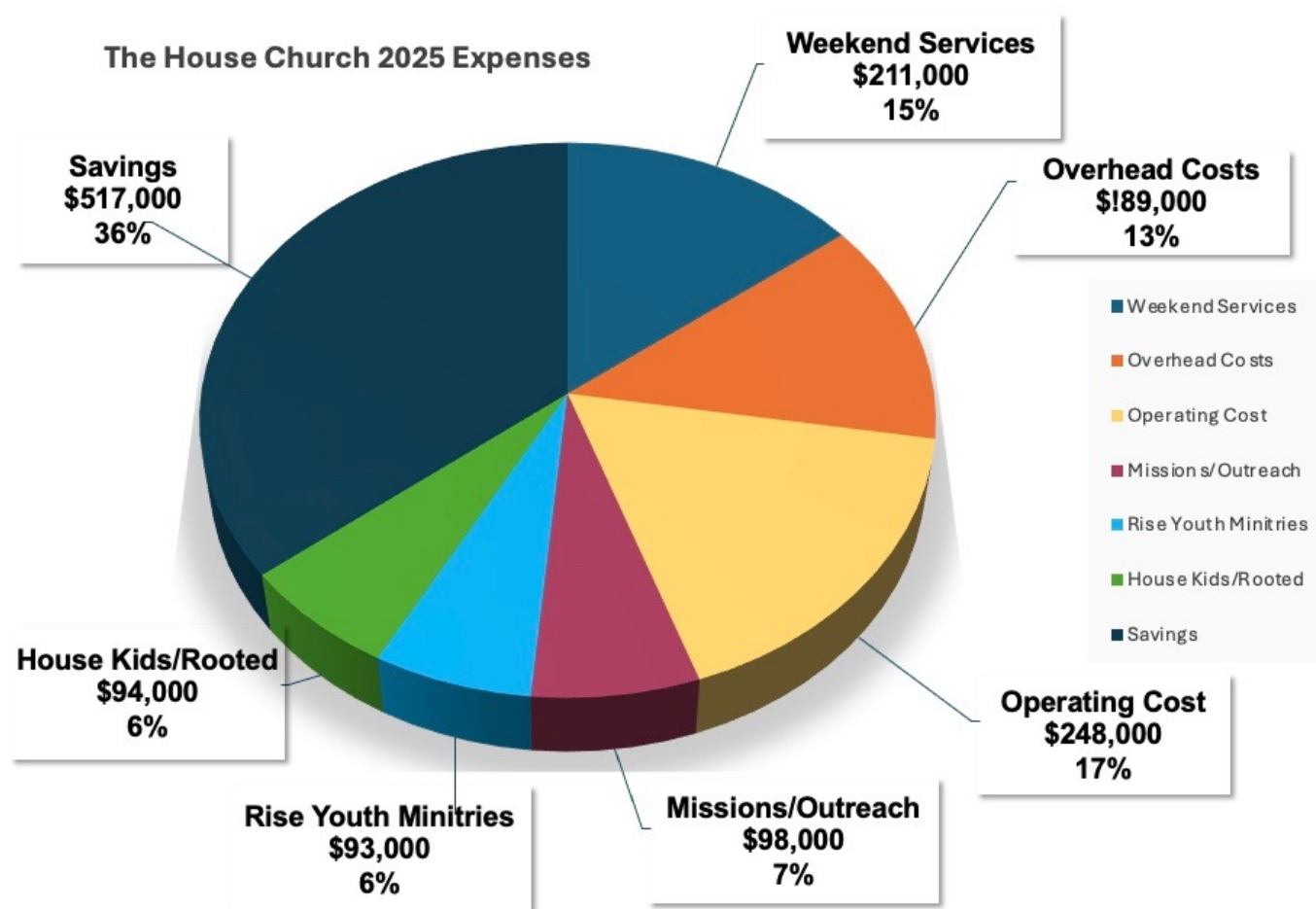

Sundays at House Kids are loud, exciting, and full of life! We serve four age groups—Nursery (infants & 1s), 2s-3s, 4s-5s, and K-6th—each designed to nurture kids in their faith journey.

Nursery is overflowing! Our team not only cares for babies but speaks life and prays over them, even before they can understand. (Show picture.)

2s-5s classes lay a foundation for kids to learn about Jesus through Bible lessons, crafts, and play.

K-6th is packed with kids hungry for Jesus! Our leaders shape their faith by teaching worship, leading small groups, and making church a place they love.

Wednesdays: Rooted (4th-6th grade) takes kids deeper—helping them apply the Bible, live for God, and prepare for Rise. Through worship, small groups, games, and a focused message, we equip them to honor God in everyday life.

Incredible Impact

100-150 kids attend Sundays; 30-40 join Rooted.

50 kids gave their lives to Christ in 2024; 21 baptized in 2025. Launched our special needs ministry in 2024.

Hosted Rooted Retreat, 240 Interns, Kids Camp, & Summer Blast. 14 preteens completed our 240 internship.

Rise Student Ministries is our youth movement for 7th–12th grade students—and let me tell you, it's loud, it's fun, and it feels like family. It's a place where students can come as they are, build real friendships, and grow in their faith while having an absolute blast.

Every week, we have 70–100 students walk through our doors, and it's not just about showing up—it's about stepping up. Our students are leading, serving, and making an impact in our church and in their schools.

Our heart for this ministry is simple: we want to see students disciplined in their faith, bold in evangelism, confident in being a light wherever they go, strong in leadership, passionate about serving, and fully understand what it means to Believe, Belong, Become, and Be the Church.

Samaritans Food Pantry: Nourishing Lives, One Meal at a Time

At *The House*, we are proud to support the **Samaritans Food Pantry**, a vital non-profit organization dedicated to providing **nutritious food** to residents of **Garvin County**. Located in **Pauls Valley**, the pantry's mission is clear: to ensure that no one in our community goes hungry.

Care Portal & Project 111

CarePortal is a **community care-sharing platform** used in Oklahoma to connect local churches and community partners with real, vetted needs of children and families involved in the child welfare system. Child welfare professionals (like caseworkers) identify needs such as housing repairs, clothing, food, or other supports, and **post them on the Care Portal platform** so nearby churches and volunteers can see and respond **in real time**. It helps communities

provide **tangible, timely support** that can help prevent further crisis, support foster families, aid in reunification, and strengthen families locally. [111 Project+2111 Project+2](#)

In Oklahoma, CarePortal operates through a **collaboration between** the nonprofit 111Project, **Oklahoma Human Services (OKDHS)**, and partner churches. OKDHS caseworkers submit the needs; CarePortal shares them with registered churches and partners; and community volunteers respond.

What is the 111Project?

111Project is an Oklahoma-based **nonprofit organization** with the mission to **mobilize the local church so every child has a family**. Its name reflects the idea of *1 Church, 1 Family, 1 Purpose*: every church partnering to support at least one family and help address the child welfare crisis in their community. [111Project](#)

Key goals and activities of the 111Project include:

- **Equipping churches** to serve children and families involved with child welfare through prayer, volunteers, training, and tangible help. [111Project](#)
- **Recruiting and supporting foster and adoptive families** so that children in foster care can be placed with loving homes. [City Lifestyle](#)
- **Using the CarePortal platform** as a primary tool for mobilizing community responses to urgent needs identified by caseworkers. [111 Project](#)
- Encouraging churches to take a pledge that includes prayer, assigning a point person, participating in CarePortal responses, and advocating in their congregations.

Their Bibles are **blank**— but together, we can change that.

That's why we partner with **IllumiNations**, a collective of global translation organizations committed to **ending Bible poverty**. Through groundbreaking collaboration and innovative translation efforts, the goal is that by **2033**:

- ✓ **95%** of people will have access to the **full Bible**.
- ✓ **99.96%** will have access to the **New Testament**.
- ✓ **100%** will have access to **at least some Scripture**.
- ✓ **100%** of the world's most strategic written languages will have **two usable translations**.

Mission Generation: Bringing Jesus to Public Schools

At *The House*, we are passionate about **raising up the next generation in faith**—and that's why we stand with **Mission Generation**. For over **20 years**, this powerful ministry has been bringing the **hope of Jesus** into **public school classrooms**, impacting students, teachers, and families worldwide.

Will and Tanja White: Compassion in Action through New International Ministries

Will and Tanja White have dedicated their lives to serving those in need, particularly in response to the **Ukrainian crisis** that has forced millions to flee their homes. As the conflict escalated, they answered the call to action, providing crucial support for Ukrainian refugees who have sought safety in major European cities, such as **Berlin**.

A Lifeline for Refugees

During the initial wave of refugees, Tanja played a pivotal role by welcoming those arriving at **Berlin's main train station**, where thousands came daily in search of safety and shelter. Her medical background as a nurse equipped her to serve in a medical tent, providing care for injuries and various illnesses, ensuring that vulnerable individuals received the attention they desperately needed.

Supporting Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs)

However, the crisis doesn't end at the borders. Within Ukraine, millions of **internally displaced persons (IDPs)** continue to face significant challenges. Will and Tanja have partnered with a local church in western Ukraine that provides housing and essential aid to hundreds of IDP refugees. This church is in constant need of supplies to sustain its life-changing efforts.

Delivering Hope and Aid Will takes on the mission of regularly driving aid supplies into Ukraine, adapting to the evolving needs of those affected by the conflict. In collaboration with their Ukrainian partners, he delivers supplies to dangerous areas, ensuring that help reaches those who need it most. Additionally, Will and Tanja bring refugees back to Berlin, where they, along with their church community, care for the needs of those they serve.

- **Medical Mission Outreach**

We hosted a medical clinic that served more than 400 people from the surrounding community, many of whom had never seen a doctor in their lifetime. Over 20 serious medical conditions were identified, providing a path toward future treatment and care. Through giving hygiene supplies, every single person felt cared for until materials ran out. The impact of this single effort will continue well beyond our days on the ground.

- **Kuyawa Special Needs School**

At Kuyawa, we refreshed essential spaces with new semi-gloss paint in the kitchen and bathrooms which improv cleanliness and daily living for more than 200 students. We also provided shoes and clothing to over 70 children from the local community. The joy on their faces and the gratitude expressed reminded us of how God meets needs in big and small ways through willing hearts.

- **Daisy Special Needs School**

At Daisy, our team completed significant construction work, including concrete

pouring, trench digging, painting, and deep cleaning, creating a safer and more usable environment for more than 300 students. Beyond what we accomplished physically, God enabled us to fund ongoing improvements, including renovations to a student bathroom currently being completed.

We also invested in long-term sustainability by funding a new chicken coop and purchasing 60 egg-laying chickens. Along with hands-on agricultural training from a local technical school, this effort provides a meaningful source of food and income for years to come living out the principle: *“Give a man a fish and he eats for a day; teach a man to fish and he eats for a lifetime.”*

- **Ministry at the Supporting Church**

Brandon was blessed to preach twice at the church that partners with Daisy School. Across the two services, more than 45 individuals came forward for prayer and salvation. Lives were changed, faith was renewed, and God’s Spirit was undeniably present!!!!

- **Prayer and Community Outreach**

Throughout the week, our team prayed with numerous individuals facing hardship, illness, and personal need. We are believing that the seeds of faith planted will grow and that God will continue providing for every person we encountered.

This incredible team of 17 House Church members served tirelessly over nine full days in Kenya. We planted, we watered, we served with joy, but God is the One who will bring the harvest. The work continues even now through the projects funded and the ministries strengthened during our time there.

Our hearts are full, our faith is strengthened, and our gratitude is overflowing. And for all who feel a stirring after hearing these stories there is room for you. The next chapter of this mission is already unfolding, and we would love for you to be part of what God is doing;
