- 9 Blessed shall he be who takes your little ones and dashes them against the rock!



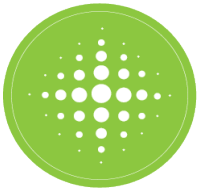

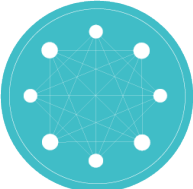

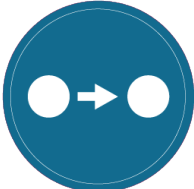
