Discussion Questions

How is it different to find your masculine identity in the Bible rather than in a life of self-serving goals? Why is God's Word a safer guide than our own subjective spiritual experience?

Genesis 2 says that man's identity includes servant lordship on God's behalf. What responsibilities has God given you and what authority has He placed in your hands? How should you act so that God is pleased and His name is praised? Are there any future responsibilities for which you should be preparing for now? How might you do that?
