Introduction

1. A Distraught Father (v. 21-24a)

- A. A man of high social standing ("synagogue leader" v. 22)
- B. Humbly seeks Jesus' help (v. 22-23)

2. A Hopeless "Daughter" (v. 24b-34)

- A. A social outcast (v. 25-26)
- B. She believes Jesus can heal her (v. 27-28; Mk. 3:10)
- C. She was "trembling with fear" after being healed (v. 33)
- D. Jesus treats her with dignity and restores her (v. 34)

3. A "Resurrected" Girl (v. 35-43)

- A. Jairus' situation has gotten worse; Jesus calls him not to fear but to believe (v. 35-36; Jn. 11:21)
- B. Sleep as a metaphor for death (Jn. 11:11-14; 1 Thess. 4:13-14; 5:10)
- C. The power of Jesus' words to bring life (v. 41-42)
 - i. A picture of Jesus' death and resurrection
 - ii. A picture of the believer's future resurrection (1 Cor. 15)
