Mark 6:1-6

Introduction

1. **Jesus Comes Home** (v.1-2a)

A. Jesus and his disciples arrive in Nazareth (v. 1)

B. Jesus teaches in the synagogue (v. 2a; Mk. 1:22)

2. **Hometown Response to Jesus** (v. 2b-3)

A. The people are amazed (v. 2b)

B. The people ask questions (v. 2b-3)

C. The people take offense (v. 3)

3. Jesus' Response to Those at Home (v. 4-6)

A. A proverb; "A prophet is not without honor..." (v. 4; Jn. 7:5)

i. Insiders vs. outsiders in the family of God (Mk. 3:21; 3:35)

B. Limited miracles and amazement at their lack of faith (v. 5-6)

i. Jesus did the miraculous in response to faith (Mk. 1:40)

ii. Their rejection foreshadows the ultimate rejection by the Jewish people at the end of Jesus' life (Mk. 15:12-14; Jn. 1:11)

1. We too many be rejected, but are called to follow Christ no matter the cost (Mk. 8:34-35)
