Introduction

King: ruler and leader of God’s people; someone who fights for and upholds justice on behalf of the people.

Priests: mediate a relationship between God and humanity.

The joy of our salvation is grounded in Jesus as our priest-king.

“What God intended to do through the prototypical priest-king Adam, he will now do, in a heightened sense, through David’s Lord. Creation and its corruption will be subjected to the rule of a righteous king.”¹
