#### Introduction

1.	A Most	Important	Question	(v.	28)

- A. A sincere question
- B. An often-debated question among Jewish teachers

#### 2. A Most Important Answer (vv. 29-31)

- A. Love God (vv.29-30; Deut. 6:4-5)
  - i. Nurture an ongoing relationship with Him
  - ii. Deal with sin
  - iii. Our love for God flows from His love for us (1 Jn. 4:10, 19)

- B. Love people (v. 31)
  - i. Loving God and loving people go together (1 Jn. 4:20-21)
  - ii. Love your neighbor (Lev. 19:18; Lk. 10:25-37; Matt. 5:43-45)

\*Who have I not viewed and/or loved as my neighbor? What action steps do I need to take to obey this command?

- 3. A Most Important Response (vv. 32-34)
  - A. The teacher of the law (vv. 32-33; Hos. 6:6; Is. 1:13-17)
  - B. Jesus (v. 34; Mk. 1:15)
